

CS160 :: Fall 2015 :: How to use Hackster

General Debuggery

- Hackster sometimes doesn't load past the top bar. Refresh.
- Sometimes you can't edit your captions immediately after uploading your photos. Save your photos and move them in appropriate order first, then navigate away from the page, then come back to it.
- Hackster likes to eat your text if you copy/paste bullet formatted things from Google Docs, for some reason.
- When you paste a video link, it takes a while to process and embed. Be patient. Actual media is much nicer than a [link to one](#).
- Please make sure you see a "changes saved" pop-up in your Story before navigating away. Just because you click the save button doesn't mean it actually worked!

1. Join **with your @berkeley.edu email and real name** at https://www.hackster.io/groups/7684/invitations?token=T75LZDTpeBJ3p_fyDaTVtA
2. Create a new project; link it to the assignment under "Communities"
3. Submit it using the red button on the top right of your project
4. Once submitted, you can edit your project as much as you want until the due date.
5. Don't worry: only you and course staff can see your project, not your classmates (unless you want to publish it publicly)

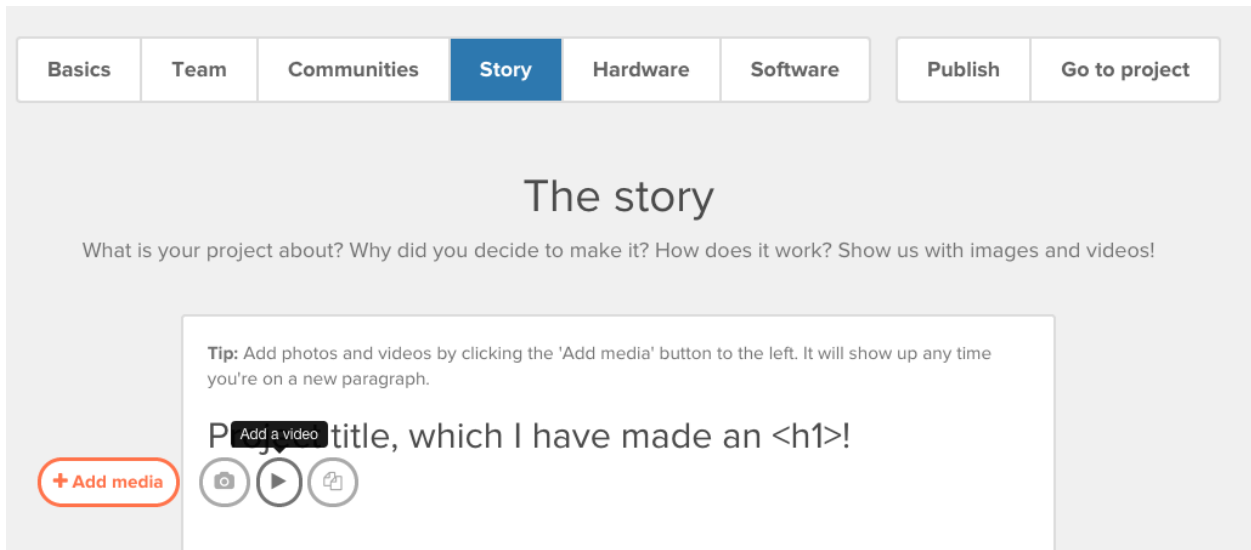

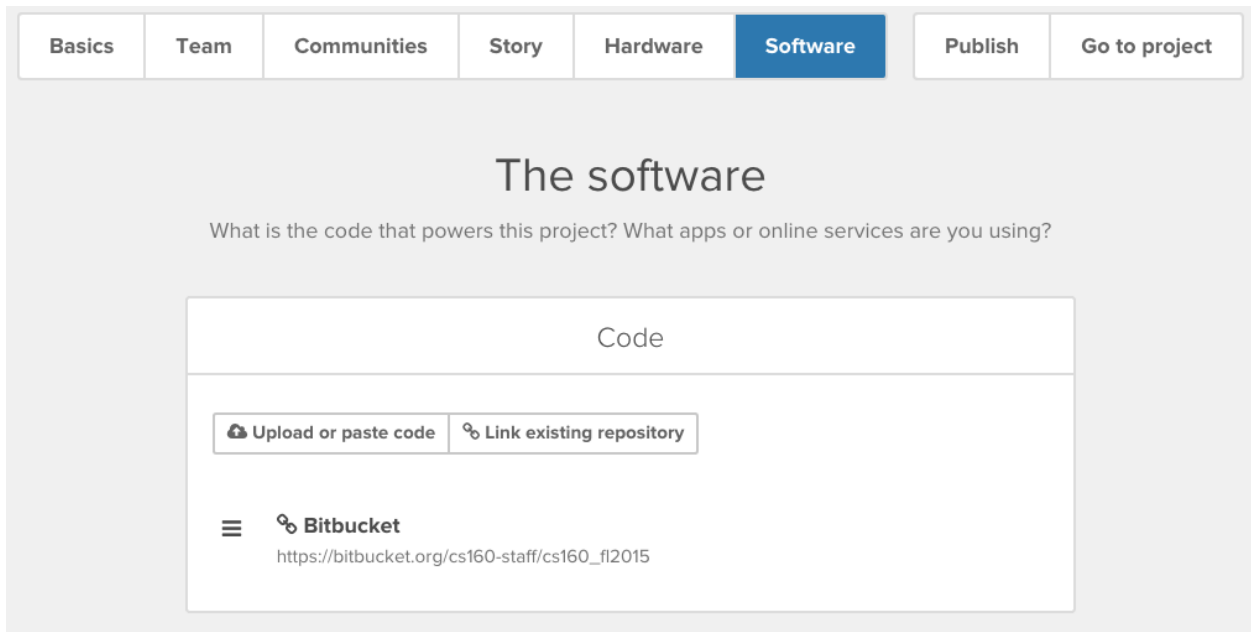

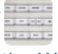
4. “The story” is how you format your project’s portfolio page. To format text, highlight it. Hackster has some weird bugs with story mode that are documented here at the top.
