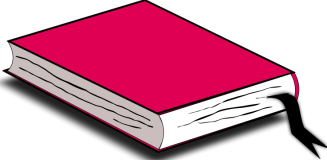
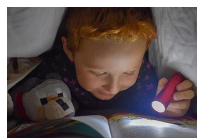


Winter Reading Challenge for 4th and 5th Grades
