

Lewy Body UK Best ECR Research Paper Award

Supported by the Lewy Body Society

Award for best research paper published in 2023 or 2024 by an Early Career Researcher in the field of Lewy body disease/Parkinson's disease. Winner/s will receive a £200 prize at the Lewy Body UK 2024 conference held at Newcastle University 18th June 2024.

Eligibility criteria

- **Applicant** must be:
 - A current student / trainee, or be within 5 years post-PhD (allowing for career disruptions, time out for clinical duties etc.)
 - First/shared author or senior author on the paper
- **Paper** submitted for consideration must be:
 - Accepted for publication or published in a peer-reviewed journal in 2023/24
 - Original research (not a review, meta-analysis etc)
 - In the field of Lewy body disease or Parkinson's disease

Judging

- Papers will be judged on the following criteria:
 - Scientific quality and impact
 - Contribution of the applicant
- Scoring breakdown (*out of 20*):
 - Quality and originality (*10 marks*)
 - Impact / significance (*5 marks*)
 - Applicant's contribution (*5 marks*)
