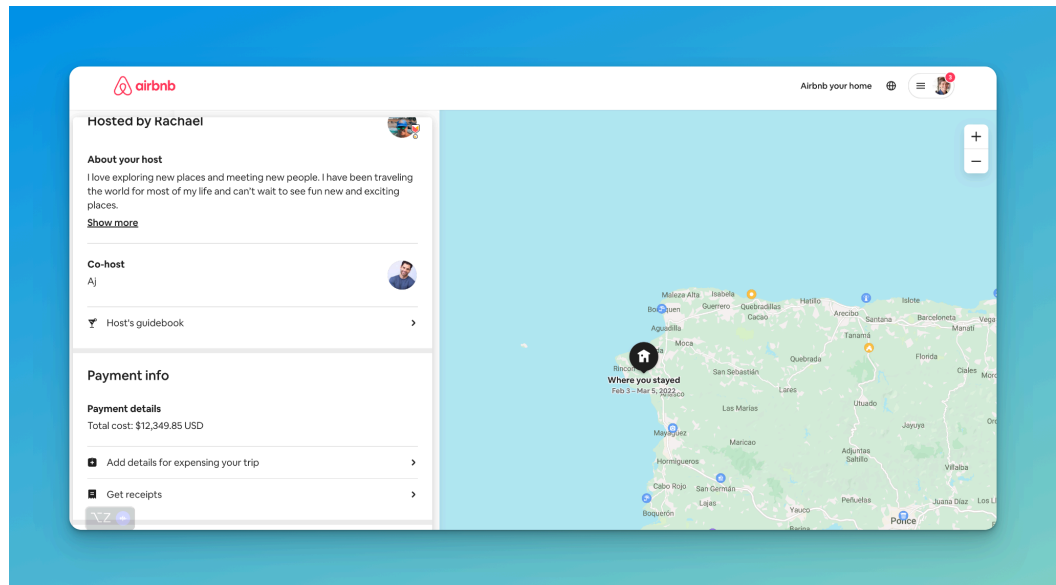
- Rent

- Fun excursion to San Juan with Drew, Chloe, Alice, and Chloe's boyfriend: **\$629 / 4 = \$157**

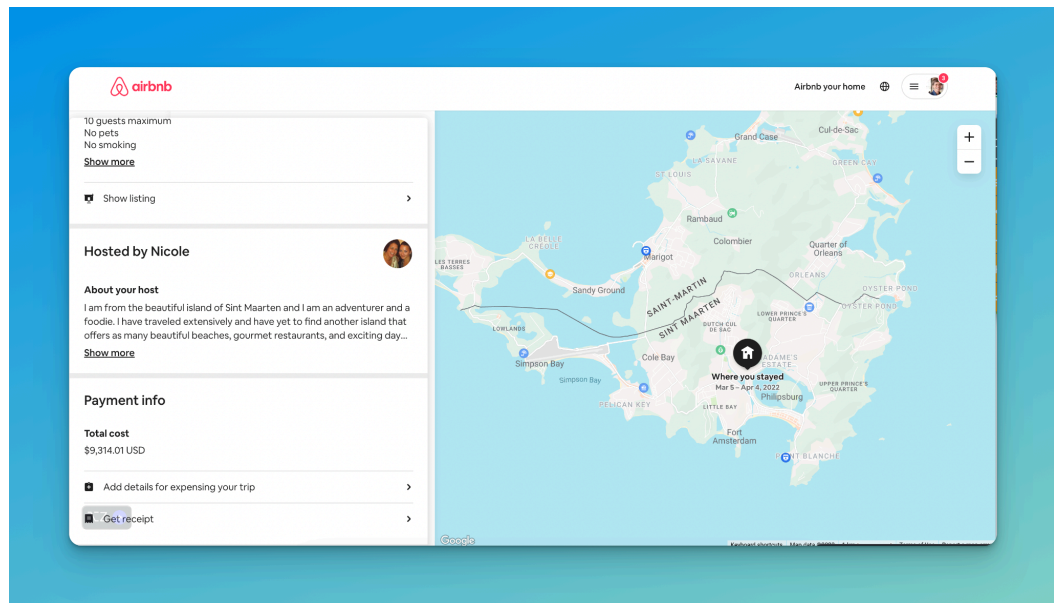

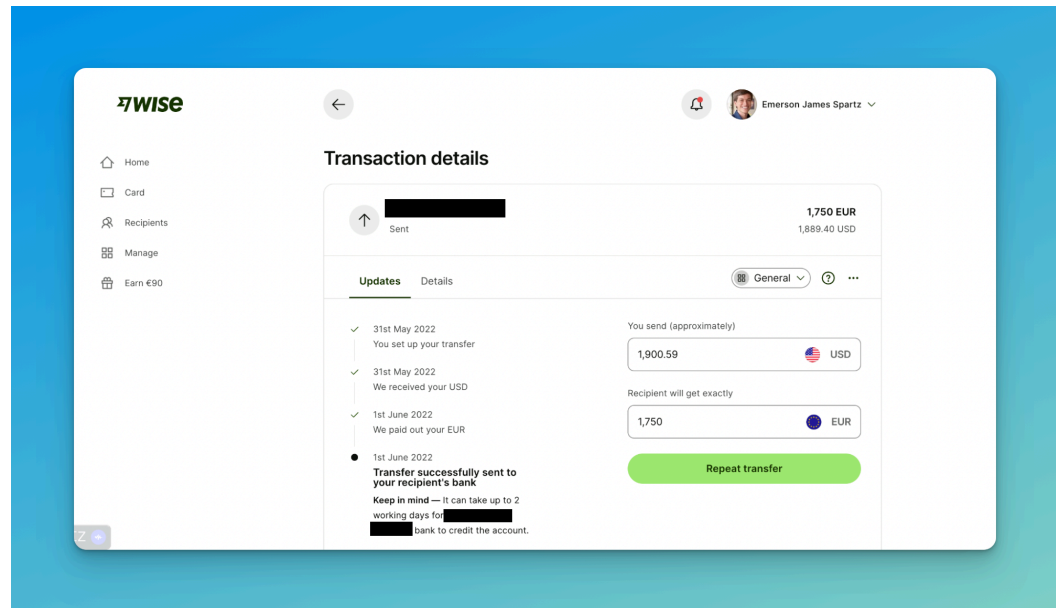


- Rental car for 7 months (**\$3360**) - \$480/month

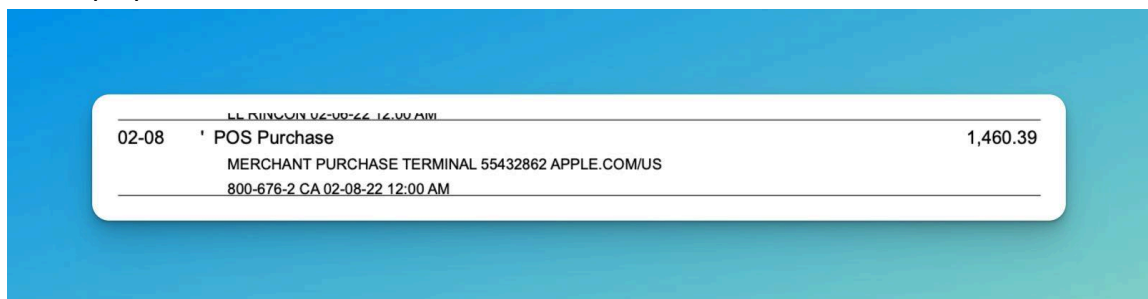




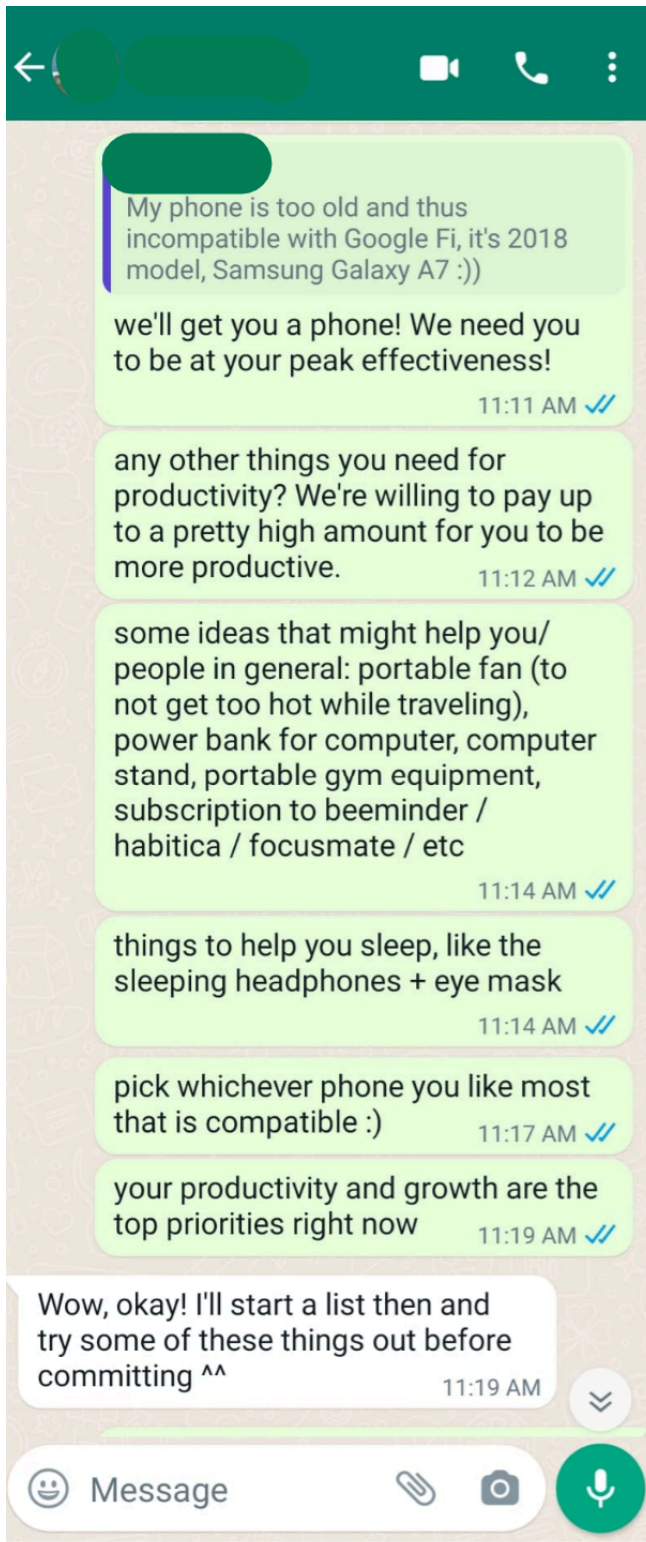
- Misc expenses we paid for: **€2175** (This includes various productivity tools and Fiverr freelancers)

- $318 + 1323 + 2058 + 480 \times 3 = \mathbf{\$5,139}$

Feb 18 - May 18 (started working with us Feb 18 till when she switched to choosing her own compensation on May 18. While working remotely and visiting family, she took a week's vacation, so that adds up to 2.75 months)

- $183+620+422+800+190+157+157+1034+2048+4041+754+480*3+1086+1086+809+2347=\$17,174$ over 2.75 months.
 - $17174/2.75=\$6,245$ per month
 - $6245*12 = \$74,940$ annualized

Post May 18 (chose her own compensation starting May 18, quit on June 19)

- $6000*12 = \$72,000$ annualized

Total:

$318+1323+2058+480*3+183+620+422+800+190+157+157+1034+2048+4041+754+480*3+1000+1000+750+2175+6000+832= \$28,742$
