Book 11 Ch12. How to MAKE Disciples of Jesus ANOINTED!

The Doctrine of the Trinity Contradicts the Bible!

How to HELP Christians See the LIGHT of the GLORY of the TWO ANOINTINGS!

Start By SimplyASKING QUESTIONS!

In other words, ask Christians "questions" in order to get them to THINK about what they **are not being taught!**

For example, here is one question that I asked in a Sunday school class while visiting the church where my daughter attends.

The class was studying what is called "the creation account" in Genesis chapter 1.

So, I asked the simple question, "Have you ever heard the teaching of other Christians that <u>Genesis 1:3-31</u> is God

RESTORING the earth after it BECAME void and without form in **Genesis 1:2**?"

Well, that one question opened the door for them to ask me questions.

In other words, some of them in the class saw right away that the BEGINNING in Genesis is not the original beginning in the eternity past when God first created the entire universe.

So then, some of them TRULY understood for the first time that God created the angels BEFORE God created Adam and Eve.

And thus, they asked me what I believed.

Do you see how that one question made them HUNGRY to learn more about what I believe?

What you want to do is you want Christians to
DESIRE what you believe, as opposed to Christians throwing up
a wall of defense against every word you speak.

With that introduction being said, I will divide this outline of examples to help others see the GLORY that has been promised for all people who BELIEVE that Jesus was raised

from the dead to be GLORIFIED in the express IMAGE of Almighty God.

This way you can scroll down quickly to each section to find these TOOLS and Scriptures to help Christians understand the TRUTH of the TRUE Gospel of Jesus ANOINTED!

Section ONE!

A Brief guide for what to do as you witness to other Christians!

The following is a list of questions that some
Trinitarian Christians may not have ever **TRULY considered**about the doctrine of the Trinity.

But you can use this same guide to help you witness to Christians who are being deceived by other church doctrines.

This is more of a guide or outline of questions that non-Trinitarian Christians can ask their fellow Trinitarian brothers and sisters in our Lord Jesus Christ to help them see the errors of the doctrine of the Trinity.

Thus, the Scriptures that I list in section four will focus on the doctrine of the Trinity.

These questions are honest and sincere questions that I believe every Trinitarian Christian should ask themselves, and then go to the Bible to search out the answers for themselves just as Acts 17:11 and 2 Timothy 2:15 teach us.

Acts 17:11.

"These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the Scriptures daily, whether those things were so."

2 Timothy 2:15.

"Study to show yourself approved unto God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

In other words, rightly discerning the word of truth so that you will never be confused concerning which church doctrines are God's truth and which church doctrines are what the Bible refers to as doctrines of devils.

So then, every Christian needs to read and study the Bible for themselves to be sure that what they are being taught is what the Bible ITSELF teaches in its entirety.

In other words, what does the WHOLE word of God itself teach us, as opposed to just some verses taken out of their context to try to support a church doctrine that is not actually found explicitly stated in the Bible itself?

Especially, when any Christian begins to see that any church doctrine actually contradicts what the whole word of God teaches us even though it uses many verses of Scriptures in the Bible to try to support the man-made church doctrine.

In other words, if you are seeing that even one verse of Scripture does not agree with any church doctrine that you have been taught, then you need to take a closer look at that church doctrine.

Again, the focus in this example guide will be one how the help Trinitarian Christians come to the realization that they are teaching another gospel that the Apostles of Jesus did not teach.

So then, after you ask the Trinitarian Christians the questions listed below, then I have some other questions and points to show them to help them understand that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of Almighty God, and not Almighty God Himself in the flesh having two natures at the same time during the days of his flesh.

Be not deceived by church doctrines that are taught with the spirit of REQUIREMENT or that must be believed in order to be saved other than the CORE Gospel of Jesus Christ.

In other words, if a church doctrine is not explicitly stated in the New Testament under the New Covenant as what we must do to be saved and receive eternal life in the world to come.

Then it should never be taught as a CORE central church doctrine that must be believed to be saved.

The TRUTH of the TRUE gospel is clearly stated in the Scriptures in simplicity with no interpretation needed.

So, if you do not know what the core true gospel of Jesus Christ is, then please read this study **Book 5 Chapter 1.**What is the TRUE Gospel of Jesus CHRIST?

For you see, what is taught as ESSENTIAL, must be believed doctrines, are almost always just merely man-made church doctrines that are either not in the Bible at all, while other church doctrines, so-called "essential" doctrines, are not rightly discerned correctly according to the WHOLE word of Almighty God.

One example of a doctrine that is not rightly discerned correctly is the rapture of the church.

For you see, there will, indeed, be a catching up of the church, but **the controversy is WHEN** the rapture of the church will take place.

And some church denominations use "intimidation" to say that if you do not "believe" in the pre-tribulation of the rapture of the church, then you will be left behind.

They use the argument in James 1 that says, let no man that wavers in their faith even think that he will receive anything from God.

And they wrongly conclude, therefore, if you DOUBT the pre-tribulation rapture, then you will not be raptured because of your own unbelief in a pre-tribulation rapture of the church.

And by making that doctrine an ESSENTIAL doctrine of a church denomination, then that makes other Christians to be looked down upon as false teachers who are not allowed to share what God has shown them concerning the rapture of the church.

And that my dear brothers and sisters in our Lord Jesus Christ is plain WRONG!

It is also wrong to use a LIE in order to instill a "godly" fear in anyone to intimidate them to believe a church doctrine that is not EXPLICITLY taught in the Scriptures.

There is nothing wrong with using "godly" fear to save a person from the lake of fire, but it is wrong to use made-man church doctrine that contradicts other verses of Scripture in the Bible.

Please read all the studies under the heading ** J-0.

Prophecy The 2nd COMING of Jesus! **

Section TWO!

But for now, back to this guide on how to lead Trinitarian Christians out of Trinitarianism by first asking them some very simple questions.

I have divided these questions into two groups of questions.

The first 10 questions are simply **general questions** that anyone can answer from their own personal experience like what do you believe and why do you believe what you have come to believe?

The second group has 27 questions that are more about what does the doctrine of the Trinity ACTUALLY teach, such as, <u>did you know that the doctrine of the Trinity</u> <u>actually contradicts what the Bible itself teaches</u>?

Now, the second group of questions will require you to read the Bible for yourself and require you to do your own research for yourself.

In other words, if you ONLY research one side of the controversy, then you will not have all of the evidence to base your conclusion upon.

But do not worry, I will give you the references to verses of Scripture to look up in the King James Bible. I say the KJV, for you see, some Trinitarian Christians only trust the KJV Bible.

I teach my readers to compare many different translations.

I will also give you links to some in-depth Bible studies on each related question.

I also have an in-depth study called **Answering the Doctrine of the Trinity!**

You can also use the questions and examples in that study, as a guide to help Trinitarian Christians see that they have been deceived by Satan, the Devil, to wrongly teach another gospel that is not the TRUTH of the gospel, but a different gospel that the Apostles did not teach.

Or you can simply just give a link to a Trinitarian of one or more of my studies, which they may or may not read on their own. What I have found is that almost all Christians are usually satisfied with what they have been taught, unless they see or come to the UNDERSTANDING of something in God's word for THEMSELVES that causes them to QUESTION what they have been taught.

So, it is best to pray for the Trinitarian Christians that you desire to help, first.

In other words, before you attend a Bible study or a Sunday school class, pray to God exactly what you desire to happen.

Call things that are not yet as though they already are. And then, BELIEVE your confessions of FAITH!

For example, Heavenly Father, You know that I am headed to attend a Sunday school class at my daughter's church.

Help me Heavenly Father to ask a question that is related to what they are studying that will open their hearts and minds to hearing the gospel of Jesus being ANOINTED by You to be empowered to do all of Your will.

And then, you can ask them what God leads you to ask them.

The questions you ask should be phrased in a way to get them to **think** about a particular verse that you yourself see and fully understand that the doctrine of the Trinity **contradicts** what the Bible itself is actually teaching.

For example, ask the following question.

"Have you ever noticed that <u>Acts 2:36</u> ACTUALLY says that God MADE the Son of MAN, Jesus, to become both Lord and Christ after the cross and resurrection?"

"How does the doctrine of the Trinity fit with what Acts 2:22-42 is actually teaching us?"

"What I mean by these questions is how does the human Son of God fit with the doctrine of the Trinity which says that God the Son became the Son of man, Jesus?"

"Do you see how being made to become Lord does not fit with the teaching that Jesus has always been Lord in the eternity past and the Lord from heaven came down to the earth to become flesh to then be made Lord does not make sense?"

Once they consider one or more verses that do not FIT with what they have been taught about Jesus having two natures at the SAME time during the days of his FLESH, then they will be more likely to read the entire study that you give to them.

While we are on this example, some will no doubt bring up the question, "What about <u>1 Corinthians 15:47</u> that states as a fact that the second man is the Lord FROM heaven?"

Show them that the Greek word "ek" also means "in" and not just the word "from". It also means origin.

Thus, the second man Adam is the Lord who is now up **in** heaven, instead of the second man, Adam, is the Lord from heaven.

The Son of MAN, Jesus, was MADE Lord, and his being made Lord over the earth during the world to come, has its origin from heaven.

In other words, the HUMAN Son of God of being made Lord came by the authority of Almighty God from heaven.

We know that the English word "in" is the correct translation because of the CONTEXT in <u>1 Corinthians</u>

15:19-28.

For you see, Jesus **BECAME the firstfruits** unto God of those who sleep or die in Jesus, when his God and Father raised him from the dead.

And then, we will become firstfruits unto God at the coming of Jesus.

And after the second harvest of firstfruits comes the third and final harvest of firstfruits unto God will be at the end of the 1000-year reign of Jesus.

So then, clearly the context is speaking about the resurrection and the Son of MAN, Jesus, ascending up into heaven to be made Lord over the whole earth during the world to come.

Therefore, the KJV has incorrectly translated verse 47 as from heaven when it should be translated as the second MAN is the Lord in heaven.

In other words, a MAN became Lord by his God and Father making His human Son both Lord and Christ, according to <u>Acts 2:36</u>.

Section THREE!

Another thing that you need to do BEFORE you begin making disciples to teach the TRUE gospel of Jesus ANOINTED is to make a list of Scriptures that have opened your eyes to come to understand that the doctrine of the Trinity

is a man-made false doctrine that contradicts what the Bible itself actually teaches.

Thus, you will need to have <u>two separate lists</u> of Scriptures, either just verse references, or note cards with the verses printed out so that you can hand them the verses to read right then and there.

You can do both ways.

I suggest having a list of Scripture references either hand-written or typed on a sheet of typing paper that you can fold and keep in the back of your Bible.

You can also have color coded tabs on the pages of your Bible that you can quickly turn to those verses of Scripture.

And underline or highlight the verse in your Bible as well so it stands out.

The second list of Scriptures can be done the same way using a different color code on the tabs and the highlighting of the Scriptures that Trinitarian Christians use to try to support their doctrine of the Trinity.

Also, you need to instruct them to make TWO lists of Scriptures as well.

For you see, they will have many QUESTIONS of their own to ask you.

Again, I suggest that each verse of Scripture that they use to try to support their doctrine of the Trinity to be printed out on a slip of paper or on a note card.

Again, you should do this ahead of time for you, yourself, to use as a visual illustration as you are presenting the truth to them.

You will see what I mean by this in a moment.

But for now, think of each verse as EVIDENCE. And as you show them that a verse they are using is not SOUND evidence, then you have them set aside that NOTE card with that verse printed out so that it can no longer be used as EVIDENCE in their argument.

Again, you will see how their list of Scriptures can be proven as not being sound Biblical EVIDENCE one verse at a time, until they have no verses left in their pile.

Just as a review, one list will be the list of Scriptures that you have compiled or grouped together that proves to you that the doctrine of the Trinity CONTRADICTS what the Bible itself actually teaches.

The reason for this list of Scriptures is that almost all of these verses of Scripture are <u>simply read right over</u> by all Trinitarian Christians.

While the other verses that they use to try to support the doctrine of the Trinity are read into the Scriptures with their Trinitarian MINDSET.

For example, very few Trinitarian Christians know or understand that Jesus was MADE a little LOWER than the angels DURING the days of his FLESH, according to Hebrews 2:5-10 and Hebrews 5:7-14.

They simply read right over verses like these and thus they do not TRULY consider how these passages of Scripture absolutely PROVE beyond any shadow of a doubt that Jesus was not full Almighty God Himself during the days of his FLESH.

For you see, the angels are not even close to being EQUAL with Almighty God who created the angels.

So then, "How can Jesus be EQUAL with Almighty God", when the Bible ITSELF clearly states as a fact that Jesus was made LOWER than the ANGELS, who we all agree are not even close to being equal to Almighty God Himself.

You can get even hard-core Trinitarian Christians to THINK about what the doctrine of the Trinity and what the doctrine of the Deity of Jesus ACTUALLY teaches by simply asking them question such as, "How can Jesus be Almighty God Himself in the FLESH when Almighty God Yahweh MADE Jesus a little LOWER that the ANGELS?"

Ask them questions like, "Are the angels co-equal with God?"

The answer is obviously no!

"Then how can the Son of MAN, Jesus be co-equal with Almighty God Himself DURING the days of his FLESH seeing that God MADE Jesus a little LOWER than the angels, according to these two passages of Scripture that you just finished reading for yourself?"

"Can you now see that the doctrine of the Trinity CONTRADICTS what the Bible ITSELF teaches?"

Again, the other list of verses on note cards or on slips of paper will be all of the verses of Scripture that are used by Trinitarian Christians as their EVIDENCE to try to prove that Jesus is Almighty God Himself in the flesh.

And I will show you how to have them see and understand that they can no longer use those verses as their evidence.

You do this by clearly explaining one verse at a time.

And after they clearly see that the verse was taken out of context and it was interpreted incorrectly, then have them openly admit that they can use that verse to try to support the doctrine of the Trinity.

Thus, they must remove that verse from their list of verses that they use to try to support their teaching that God the Son BECAME flesh.

Work on those easy verses first so that they can see their pile of so-called evidence growing smaller and smaller.

Then you can explain how their other verses are incorrectly translated.

Now, before we get into more verses of Scripture like this first example, let us begin with the first 10 **general** questions to ask your fellow brothers and sisters in the Lord who may believe in the doctrine of the Trinity, the doctrine of Oneness Pentecostal Christians, or the doctrine of the Deity of Jesus having TWO natures at the SAME time during the days of

his FLESH before moving on to the next 27 questions about the doctrine of the Trinity.

The first 10 questions are asked to see if the Trinitarian Christians that you are reaching out to, if they sincerely believe that they <u>MUST believe</u> in the doctrine of the Trinity <u>in order to be saved</u> or <u>in order to be a TRUE</u>

<u>Christian</u>.

If you already know for SURE that they do not consider the doctrine of the Trinity an ESSENTIAL doctrine that must be believed in order to be saved, then you can skip the following ten questions when sharing the gospel of ANOINTED with them.

But if they do sincerely believe that the doctrine of the Trinity MUST be believed or they are not truly saved, then you need to show them that FEAR comes from MAN and not from God.

I will show you how to do that shortly.

Section FOUR!

The First 10 General Questions.

Here are the first ten GENERAL questions to use as a guide.

Feel free to add more questions and also rephrase any question that fits how you communicate to others.

- #1. Do you believe in the doctrine of the Trinity?
- #2. Since you believe in the doctrine of the Trinity then why do you believe in the doctrine of the Trinity?
- #3. Did your church denomination teach you the doctrine of the Trinity?
- #4. However, you came to believe in the doctrine of the Trinity have you ever read or have been told that you MUST believe in the doctrine of the Trinity in order to be saved?
- #5. Do **YOU yourself sincerely believe that you MUST believe** in the doctrine of the Trinity in order to be saved or in order to be a TRUE Christian?
- #6. If so, then was the doctrine of the Trinity **a part of the gospel that brought you** to the saving faith to believe in
 Jesus as your savior?

They should say no. For you see, I have never met a Christian yet who was taught that the only way to be saved is to believe that God is three separate persons in one God.

#7. Now, seeing that the doctrine of the Trinity was not part of the gospel that caused you to believe in Jesus, and you were saved before you ever heard of the doctrine of the Trinity, then WHY do you believe and or teach that one MUST believe in the doctrine of the Trinity in order to be saved?

#8. Why is there even a doctrine of the Trinity, seeing that it is not a part of the gospel of salvation?

#9. Why do YOU YOURSELF believe in the doctrine of the Trinity?

#10. Are you OPEN to hearing WHY I myself believe that **the Bible ITSELF does not teach** the doctrine of the Trinity, the doctrine of Oneness Pentecostalism, or the doctrine of the Deity of Jesus DURING the days of his FLESH having two natures at the SAME time?

Let them know that you do indeed believe in the DEITY of Jesus, but **you do not believe what the church**

council at Chalcedon decreed as church dogma that must be believed, or you were excommunicated from the Roman Catholic Church at that time in the history of the church.

I suggest that you have the following quote on cardstock that you can use over and over.

Or have several copies that you can give out to those you witness to.

Here is a quote from another website explaining **what** the council at **Chalcedon in 451 AD** was all about.

"The Council of Chalcedon was called in 451 CE by the Roman Emperor Marcian (r. 450-457) to settle debates regarding the nature (hypostases, "reality") of Christ that had begun at two earlier meetings in Ephesus (431 CE and 439 CE).

The question was whether Christ was human or divine, a man who became God

(through the resurrection and ascension) or God who became a man (through the

incarnation, "taking on flesh"
his humanity and divinity affected his
essence and being, if at all."

In other words, ALL Christians at that time in history agreed that Jesus was DEITY or had a divine NATURE.

But the question or DEBATE was **HOW was Jesus Deity**? When was Jesus Deity?

And did the Son of man, Jesus, become deity after the cross and resurrection?

Or did a pre-existing God become a man who remained fully God during the days of his flesh having BOTH natures at the SAME time, one Divine and one human, DURING the days of his FLESH?

After you have determined why a brother or sister believes in the doctrine of the Trinity, the doctrine of Oneness Pentecostalism, or the two natures at the same time doctrine of the Deity of Jesus, then you can move on to the next group of questions.

This next group of questions is about what the doctrine of the Trinity ACTUALLY teaches.

Some of these questions are the kind that ask the questions, "did you know this or that".

It is those types of questions concerning the doctrine of the Trinity that are very effective.

For you see, some Trinitarian Christians have no idea what the doctrine of the Trinity actually teaches.

Section FIVE!

The Second List of 27 Trinity Questions.

This list is more detailed as to why you are asking these questions.

So, while this section seems quite long, it is not really any longer than the actual 27 questions.

The following is my teaching or my explanation for why I ask questions, and also how to ask the questions is love, having the right attitude.

Here are the 27 questions with detailed instructions.

Thus, on the sheet you keep in your Bible will only have the questions and not the detailed instructions.

#1. Do YOU yourself know what the doctrine of the Trinity teaches well enough to explain it to me?

In other words, you are asking them the question, "Can you explain to me in your own words what you yourself understand what the doctrine of the Trinity teaches?"

Listen to their explanation of the doctrine of the Trinity.

You want to know if **they understand** what the Trinitarian terms co-eternal and co-equal actually mean.

You are learning what <u>they themselves believe</u> because not all Trinitarian Christians believe the same thing.

So, keep asking a few more questions before you get into the Scriptures.

The purpose of this first question is to get them to tell you in their own words what they believe, as opposed to you telling them what the doctrine of the Trinity teaches.

That way, they cannot backtrack and argue that you are putting words into their mouth.

#2. Are God the Father and His Son Jesus one and the same being?

For you see, some Trinitarians are more Oneness Pentecostal believers than they are Trinitarian Christians.

So, point blank ask them the questions, if Jesus is the Father, as in, did the Father manifested Himself to become flesh?

If they say no and that it was God the SON who became flesh, then move on to the next question.

You want to make sure that they are the ones saying that Jesus is not one and the self-same BEING as the Father.

In other words, you want them to tell you that Jesus is indeed a SEPARATE person than the Father.

And you also want them to tell you that Jesus is a separate BEING from the Father.

#3. So then, since the doctrine of the Trinity teaches that Jesus and Almighty God the Father are separate distinctly different persons, and they are NOT one and the self-same being then would that not be two separate Gods?

Wait to hear what they say. Then expound a little more.

What I mean by this question is have them suppose that there is a mighty King over a VAST kingdom who has a son.

And that great King APPOINTED his son to rule over a small section of his vast kingdom.

Would the son, who was appointed king over part of the great King's vast empire be ONE and the self-SAME King as the great King?

Or would there be two SEPARATE Kings who are ruling over the same Kingdom?

#4. So then, let me get this straight. Are you saying that the doctrine of the Trinity teaches the Father and His Son are NOT two separate Gods?

And, are you saying that the doctrine of the Trinity calls each of them, the Father and His Son, separate persons who are ONE and the self-same God?

But yet, you can clearly see that the great King and His Son, whom He himself appointed as "A" King over ONLY a

small section of His vast kingdom are NOT one and the self-same "King".

You can clearly see that they are two SEPARATE persons, AND that they are two separate Kings ruling together in unity in the ONE kingdom.

So then, WHY can you not see that Jesus and his God are two separate God's?

Please be patient and hear me out as to why I believe that the Bible ITSELF does not teach us that Jesus is Almighty God Himself in the flesh.

Be patient and I will show you that the Bible itself actually teaches us that Jesus BECAME a King, a Messiah, a Lord, and yes, the Son of MAN, Jesus, also BECAME a God under and subject to his God and Father after the cross and resurrection.

Then you can show them Psalm 2:1-12, Psalm 89:27, John 18:37, plus many other verses of Scripture that prove that the Son of MAN, Jesus, BECAME a King by God setting him and exalting him to be a King.

#5. How can three SEPARATE beings or persons who are all three called God according to the doctrine of the Trinity be the ONE SELF-SAME true God if they are NOT one and the self-same BEING?

And if they are one and the selfsame BEING, then how can they be separate PERSONS?

They will try and use the argument that there is one WHAT and three WHO'S.

If they do, then point out the verses in the New Testament that ALWAYS clearly identifies the ONE God or the one WHAT as being the FATHER.

Let them think about that while you ask them the next question.

In other words, tell them to keep that in MIND while you are asking them another question that is related.

If they do not know of any verses showing that God is the Father, then you give them the verses that always clearly identify the Father as being God.

You can refer to the studies **W-4. Jesus Is NOT**Almighty God the Father in the FLESH!

And also read the study called <u>W-6. Verses PROVE</u>

Jesus is NOT the FATHER!

Those two studies will give you all of the verses that clearly identify God as being the Father ALONE.

#6. Are the Father and His Son, Jesus, the same ONE God in ONE BEING or are they the ONE God in UNITY like the example of the two separate Kings?

See the following verses found in Malachi 2:10, Mark 12:28-32, Deuteronomy 6:4,5, Romans 3:23-30, 1 Corinthians 8:6, Ephesians 4:6, and 1 Timothy 2:3-7.

#7. The Father and His Son Jesus are not one and the same God in ONE being.

Rather, they are ONE in UNITY only.

But if Trinitarian Christians argue that the Father and Son are the same God in one BEING, then would that not be having TWO separate persons who are both called by the TITLE of God who BOTH are UNITED together as ONE in purpose to do the will of the ONE true God who alone is the Father?

You want them to see that the word "God" is a TITLE just like the word "King" is a TITLE, and the word "Lord" is a TITLE.

Then point out that Jesus was MADE Lord AFTER the cross, according to <u>Acts 2:36</u>.

And in <u>Psalm 110:1,2</u>, Jesus was SET or appointed to be Yahweh's King who shall be called by the NAME the Mighty El or the Mighty God, according to <u>Psalm 2:6</u>, <u>Psalm 89:27</u>, and <u>Isaiah 9:6,7</u>.

#8. Did you know that Jesus will rule FOR the Father for 1000 years in the world to come only over the earth?

Did you know that Jesus will step down from ruling on God's throne after the 1000 years comes to an end?

See <u>Revelation 20:1-15</u>, <u>1 Corinthians 15:20-28</u>, and <u>Psalm 110:1-4</u>.

Also, see the prophecy in <u>Isaiah 40:10</u> of the arm of Yahweh shall rule FOR Him or for Yahweh.

See also, Isaiah 41:2, and Isaiah 49:1-6.

#9. Did you know that Almighty God is the God OF His Son Jesus, who he MADE both Lord and Christ after the cross and resurrection, according to <u>Acts 2:22-42</u>, which is the very first GOSPEL message?

Please read <u>Ephesians 1:17</u>, <u>Romans 15:6</u>, <u>2 Corinthians 1:3</u>, <u>2 Corinthians 11:31</u>, <u>Ephesians 4:6</u>, <u>Colossians 1:3</u>, and <u>1 Peter 1:3</u>.

#10. So then, are you seeing or at least starting to see and understand that the Bible ITSELF clearly teaches us that Jesus was not Almighty God Himself in the FLESH from his Virgin birth to the cross and resurrect DURING the days of his FLESH?

Are you now seeing that the Son of MAN, Jesus, became a Deity or a Lord and a God AFTER the cross and resurrection?

Or are you holding fast to the teaching of the doctrine of the Trinity that states that Jesus was fully the Almighty God and fully a man at the same time on the earth having two natures at the SAME time DURING that days of his FLESH, one divine, and one human?

If you do not believe that the Scriptures that I have shown to you prove that the human Son of God, Jesus, BECAME a God AFTER the cross and resurrection, then where are the verses in the Bible itself that say that Jesus had a divine nature while he was on the earth?

For you see, the phrase "divine nature" is only found ONE time in the entire Bible, which is in 2 Peter 1:4.

And in that verse of Scripture, we are also given the promise that we will be made partakers of the "divine nature" of immortality at the coming of Jesus.

And also, the Bible itself teaches us that Jesus will not rule as God of the whole earth until the world yet to come.

Even now in heaven, Jesus is called a PRINCE, according to **Revelation 1:5**.

Also, see Acts 3:15, and Acts 5:31.

For you see, Jesus will not be crowned the King of kings, until it is time for him to return to the earth with his armies from heaven to deliver God's people and execute the wrath of God. See **Revelation 19:11-16**.

#11. So then, since the Bible itself teaches us that BOTH the Father is called God and His Son is called God, then do YOU yourself believe that they are both the ONE and only Almighty God who created the entire universe and all that exists?

Or does the Bible itself teach us that the Father is the ONLY TRUE God who ALONE is the Almighty God and His Son Jesus is a God who is under and subject to his God and Father?

See all the verses listed under question #9 as well as these following verses found in <u>Matthew 27:46</u>, <u>Mark 15:34</u>, <u>John 20:17</u>, <u>Revelation 3:12</u>, and <u>Mark 12:29</u>.

Plus, there are many PROPHECIES in the Old Testament, such as <u>Psalm 22:1,2,10</u>, and <u>Psalm 84:10</u>, referring to Jesus, and in those prophecies, Jesus calls Yahweh his God, by saying my God.

Yet, there is not one verse that says Jesus is the God of the Father.

So then, the same God OF Jesus is our God and Father.

Please see <u>1 Thessalonians 1:2,3</u>, <u>Revelation 7:10</u>, <u>Revelation 12:10</u>, <u>Romans 1:8</u>, <u>1 Corinthians 1:4</u>, and <u>Philippians 4:19</u>.

#12. So then, how can an Almighty God have another God over him?

There can only be ONE TRUE God who ONLY is the Potentate and who ONLY and ALONE is the source of all life as the giver of life, mortal life, and eternal life.

For you see, if one says that Jesus is Almighty God Himself in the flesh, then they are actually saying that the Bible is a LIE, because the Father is the God OF Jesus.

And the very meaning of the word "Almighty" means that the ONE God in ONE person who alone is the Almighty God can NOT have another God over Himself or that God OVER him would then BE THE Almighty God.

But the Bible itself clearly teaches us that Yahweh the Father is THE God OF gods.

And the gods are real gods, which He Himself APPOINTED to be gods under Himself.

God made Moses to be a god in the sight of Pharaoh, according to **Exodus 7:1**.

Moses is a figure of Jesus.

And Yahweh prophesied that He would raise up a Prophet like unto Moses, according to Deuteronomy 18:15-18.

The children of Israel did not want to hear God's terrible voice anymore.

But rather, they wanted a MAN to lead them, and Jesus is that MAN named Israel which means "He shall rule AS God".

The angels are called Elohim which is translated as gods and mighty ones.

Please read <u>John 17:1-3</u>, <u>1 Timothy 6:12-16</u>, and <u>John 5:17-30</u>.

Also, see the verses that teach us that Yahweh is the God OF all other Gods found in <u>Deuteronomy 10:17</u>, <u>Joshua 22:22</u>, <u>Psalm 136:2</u>, <u>Daniel 2:47</u>, and <u>Daniel 11:36</u>.

#13. Please understand that just because the Bible itself says that the Father is the ONLY TRUE God does NOT mean that Jesus is a FALSE God.

For you see, God the Father is the God OF our Lord Jesus Christ who MADE, set, appointed, ordained, and created to BECOME a God, to rule FOR Yahweh in the world to come, UNTIL the Father puts all the enemies under his feet.

That is what the Bible PROPHESIES, and that is what we see as having been FULFILLED and is yet to be fulfilled.

So, my question to you is where are the PROPHECIES that prophesy a pre-existing Almighty God the Son coming down from heaven and incarnating Himself to be flesh AND remaining the fully Almighty God having TWO natures at the SAME time DURING the days of his FLESH?

And if you can not show me any such verses of prophetic Scriptures, then are you saying that you are above the Bible itself and it is impossible for the man-made doctrine of the Trinity to be in error?

#14. Did you know that the word "God" is a TITLE and that we must look at the CONTEXT of that word "God" to see if it is speaking of Yahweh the Father or if it is speaking of Jesus or if it is speaking of someone else called God?

Simply read the ORDER of the events prophesied in **Isaiah 9:6.7** and you will see that the FIRST order of events is that a CHILD would be born and THEN a Son would be given, speaking of the HUMAN Son prophesied to be born of a WOMAN. THEN his NAME shall be CALLED the Mighty God WHEN the government shall be laid upon his shoulders.

So, Jesus was PROPHESIED to be NAMED or CALLED God.

And we can clearly see that Jesus was MADE Lord AFTER the cross and that was WHEN the Son of MAN, was GIVEN all power and authority BY his God and Father, according to Matthew 28:18.

And that is also when Thomas called Jesus my Lord and my God.

It was also AFTER the cross that the prophecy of Almighty God the Father calling His Son God as well.

#15. So then, how could Jesus be a so-called pre-existing God the Son in the eternity past when the Bible itself teaches us that Jesus was MADE a God under his God AFTER the cross?

Did you know that the Greek word "theos" can be translated as God, a God, god, gods, a god, a God under the God, a god under the God, and even as a goddess?

And do you understand that the only way to know if the word "God" is speaking of the ONLY TRUE God is by the CONTEXT?

Many times, the definite article "the" will precede the word "God" to let us know that the word God is referring to Yahweh.

And if the definite article "the" is not in the original Greek text then the context should tell us.

But if the context is not clear then we are to determine the TRUE meaning of Jesus as being CALLED God by the WHOLE word of God.

And the New Testament ALWAYS clearly identifies the FATHER as being THE ONLY TRUE God who alone is the ALMIGHTY God and the God OF His Son Jesus.

And that means that Jesus is "A" God under and subject to his God and NOT that Jesus is Almighty God Himself in the flesh.

Again, see every verse listed in question #9, in question #11, and in question #12.

#16. Did you know that the Bible ITSELF teaches us that the Father and his Son Jesus are indeed TWO SEPARATE Gods?

One God is under and subject to his God and Father!

And the other God is the Almighty God, who made

His human Son become a God over the whole earth to JUDGE

Satan and the fallen gods.

THINK for yourself! How can the Father, who is the ONLY TRUE God, who alone is that ALMIGHTY God and the GOD of His Son Jesus, be one and the same God as His Son seeing Jesus is a God under and subject to his God and Father?

Again, see <u>John 17:3</u>, <u>1 Timothy 6:12-16</u>, and <u>1 Corinthians 15:2, 20-28</u> along with all the verses in question #15.

#17. Do YOU, as a Trinitarian, worship Jesus? I as well worship Jesus, honor Jesus, give thanks to Jesus, praise Jesus, talk to Jesus in prayer and take authority over Satan in the

MIGHTY NAME of Jesus, but I no longer can believe the doctrine of the Trinity, because it contradicts the word of God in so many ways.

I believe that the Bible itself clearly teaches that Almighty God Himself CHOSE to highly exalt a MAN to become a God to rule for Him in the world to come for 1,000 years.

And God is doing this, so that Almighty God, the Father, cn judge the world **by the MAN** that He Himself ORDAINED, according to **Acts 17:22-31**.

Therefore, who are we to say that it is impossible for there to be TWO Gods.

Please read the study **Are There Two TRUTHFUL**Who are Both Called Gods?

#18. So then, are you going to REJECT what the Bible ITSELF teaches to cling to the man-made doctrine of the Trinity that took almost four centuries to develop?

#19. Have you ever done any research on your OWN, for YOURSELF, to see HOW and WHY the doctrine of the Trinity came to be?

Here is a <u>Biblical Unitarian article on the Trinity</u> <u>Before Nicaea</u>.

Let me just say briefly that men of God did not start out to create any church doctrine, but rather, they were simply trying to understand what the Bible means by Jesus being the SON OF the living God.

So, rather than the Scriptures being their sole foundation, they REASONED within themselves that Jesus MUST have had a DIVINE NATURE based solely on seeing that God is his FATHER.

And that is how the doctrine of the Trinity began to develop over hundreds of years.

It was basically started by asking "philosophical" questions that led to an ASSUMED conclusion that since Almighty God the Father has a divine nature, then His Son MUST ALSO have a divine nature.

Here again is a quote from another website explaining what the council at Chalcedon in 451 AD was all about.

"The Council of Chalcedon was called in 451 CE by the Roman Emperor Marcian (r. 450-457) to settle debates regarding the nature (hypostases, "reality") of Christ that had begun at two earlier meetings in Ephesus (431 CE and 439 CE).

The question was whether Christ was human or divine, a man who became God

(through the resurrection and ascension) or God who became a man (through the incarnation, "taking on flesh"), and how his humanity and divinity affected his essence and being, if at all."

In other words, ALL Christians at that time in history agreed that Jesus was DEITY or had divine NATURE.

But the question or DEBATE was **HOW was Jesus Deity**? When was Jesus Deity?

And did the Son of man, Jesus, become deity after the cross and resurrection?

Or did a pre-existing God become a man who remained fully God during the days of his flesh having BOTH natures at the SAME time, one Divine and one human, DURING the days of his FLESH?

After you have determined why a brother or sister believes in the doctrine of the Trinity, the doctrine of Oneness Pentecostal Christians, or the two natures at the same time doctrine of the Deity of Jesus, then you can move on to the next group of questions.

This next group of questions is about what the doctrine of the Trinity ACTUALLY teaches.

Some of these questions are the kind that ask the questions, "did you know this or that".

It is those types of questions concerning the doctrine of the Trinity that are very effective.

For you see, some Trinitarian Christians have no idea what the doctrine of the Trinity actually teaches.

#20. Did you know that the word "Trinity" is not found in the Bible?

Look up the word "Trinity" in any Bible concordance.

Look up the phrase, "three persons in one God" in any Bible concordance.

Look up the phrase, "two natures at the same time" in any Bible concordance.

My point is that there is no clear teaching in the New Testament about Almighty God being made up of three separate persons.

Satan has DECEIVED the whole world and that includes Satan having deceived the WHOLE church in one doctrine or another.

But God prophesied in <u>Daniel 12:3,4, that knowledge</u> would be INCREASED in the last days and the WISE would <u>UNDERSTAND</u> and turn many to righteousness.

#21. Did you know that the phrase "God the Son" is NOT found in the Bible?

Look up the phrase "God the Son" in any Bible concordance.

The only word used by Trinitarian teachers that is in the Bible is the word "Godhead".

It appears three times in the KJV, but did you know that each word in the original Greek text is a DIFFERENT Greek word.

Please see the study called <u>Colossians 2:9 What Does</u>

<u>Godhead TRULY Mean?</u>

#22. Did you know that the phrase "God the Holy Spirit" is NOT found in the Bible and that the Holy Spirit has no name other than being called the FATHER?

Look up the phrase "God the Holy Spirit" in any Bible concordance.

And please read the study Why the Holy Spirit is the FATHER!

#23. Did you know that the Bible does NOT teach that the Son of God is EQUAL to the Father?

Always remember that Jesus was MADE a little LOWER than the angels DURING the days of his FLESH, and then, God **CROWNED** with glory and honor **to OBTAIN a more excellent NAME than the angels, AFTER** the cross and resurrection

Please read the study <u>John 5:18 Jesus Making</u> <u>Himself Equal with God!</u>

#24. Did you know that the Bible does NOT clearly teach us that the Holy Spirit is a SEPARATE DISTINCT PERSON from the Father?

But rather, the New Testament teaches us more so that Almighty God the Father and his Holy Spirit are ONE and the SELF-SAME eternal Spirit.

Again, please read the study Why the Holy Spirit is the FATHER!

That study will give you all of the verses that, to me, clearly show that there is but ONE eternal Spirit, who alone is Almighty God the Father.

#25. Did you know that Jesus became God's eternal Son AFTER the cross?

Please read the following three-part study.

#26. Did you know that the Bible teaches that Jesus first came into existence at the Virgin birth?

Simply read HOW the word became flesh in Luke 1:26-38 and please notice that the Bible itself does not say that God the Son came down from heaven to become flesh.

It simply says that the "word" became flesh. The word was NOT capitalized in earlier translations of the Bible.

The word is God's spoken word of PROPHECY that came out from God's mouth.

Please watch this short 5-minute video where a well-known Trinitarian teacher openly agrees that the word in John 1:1 is NOT a separate divine person who was with God in the eternity past.

#27. Did you know that the Bible ITSELF does NOT teach us that the Word is a SEPARATE divine being from Yahweh, who was with Yahweh at His side for all eternity past?

Below is a list of all the studies that I have written on WHY the Bible ITSELF does NOT teach the doctrine of the Trinity.

I also show why the doctrine of the Trinity is NOT an issue of salvation as some Trinitarian churches dogmatically demand.

For you see, when Trinitarians say things like, "If you do not believe in the doctrine of the Trinity, then you are not a true Christian", then that is dogmatically demanding that the doctrine of the Trinity must be believed in order to be saved and receive eternal life in the world to come.

You see, Trinitarian Christians argue that anyone who denies that Jesus is Almighty God Himself in the flesh is not saved because John 8:24 says that you will remain dead in your sin if you do not believe I am [he].

According to ALL of the Apostles!

In that chapter, I cover **Ephesians 4:13**, which is about coming into the UNITY of the FAITH, as in, the faith of the Apostles of Jesus, and not the faith in church TRADITION, which the Roman Catholic Church invented.

And many Protestant church denominations kept the doctrine of the Trinity when they protested against other false doctrine in the Roman Catholic Church.

I implore you to NOT be intimidated with fear to believe ANY Christian doctrine or to believe that you MUST be a part of a certain church denomination CLAIMING that they ALONE have the truth and if you are not a part of THEIR church then you are not saved and cannot be saved until you are baptized in THEIR church.
