Ways to encourage pupils to like writing in English:

- 1. Creative book reports
- 2. Create mini books
- 3. Open a blog for the pupils and let them share their writing assignments on the blog.
- 4. Open a whatsapp group.
- 5. Send them short emails and ask them to correspond with you
- 6. Use Edmodo or another educational network to correspond with the students.
- 7. Writing comics
- 8. Writing instructions for a game
- 9. Write outside of the class go to the school yard
- 10. Ask students to write about something they like
- 11. Ask pupils to use colors / stickers while writing
- 12. Write about themselves
- 13. Real / imaginary pen pals
- 14. Write letters to people they love
- 15. The pupils can make a poster describing their favorite character
- 16. Fun book reports
- 17. Pupils will present a nice book they have read
- 18. Pulis will make book covers
- 19. Write subtitles to a short movie
- 20. Pupils can write a letter asking for advice distribute letters to pupils and they write back their advice.

Ways to encourage pupils to like reading books in English:

- 1. Ask the pupils to create something after reading (puppets).
- 2. Silent reading at the beginning of each lesson.
- 3. Read out loud to pupils.
- 4. Get them familiar with different kinds of authors or the different levels available at the library
- 5. Make a membership to an English youth newspaper in which they can read about relevant topics in English
- 6. Teach the pupils how to choose a book
- 7. Read online stories .
- 8. Start with a book that they can read easily so they don't feel frustrated
- 9. Start with a book they already know.
- 10. Prepare a reward system / chart for reading
- 11. Encourage 5-10 minutes of reading at home with their parents 3-4 times a week.

Ways to encourage pupils to use social media / internet / sites in English to improve their English:

- 1. Kahoot make for the pupils or let the pupils make the games
- 2. Music and singing
- 3. Creative websites
- 4. Internet Books at school and at home
- 5. Galim and Ofek
- 6. Open an English website to the class where you can post interesting sites songs that are sung in class...
- 7. Send links to students as homework
- 8. Quizlet, Youtube
- 9. Have the students make book reports using a "Goodreads Group" Pupils have ti respond to at least one one other student'; review (goodreads.com)
- 10. Give tasks which require going to the internet
- 11. Use English games
- 12. Make comics online
- 13. Have some of your lessons in the computer room

Ways to encourage pupils to say it is important to learn English:

- 1. Talk about why it is important in class.
- 2. Give them examples from real life.
- 3. Tell them personal experiences in which knowing English helped you.
- 4. Read the news / interesting things with the pupils
- 5. Tell them about travelling to different countries
- 6. They should know we live in a "Global Village" and it's important to communicate with people outside their country
- 7. Use lyrics from favorite/popular songs
- 8. Use the word <u>important</u> a lot "you really studied, I can see English is <u>important</u> to you" make it a mantra

- 7. Give some easy tasks every once in a while

Ways to encourage pupils to love English:

- 1. Songs and movies
- 2. Love your pupils
- 3. Make the lesson a big party
- 4. Make English lessons different from other lessons by singing, playing, moving, acting etc
- 5. Use visual aids and integrate activities and games that activate the pupils.
- 6. Making plays on holidays such as a Purim Play
- 7. Begin every lesson with a chant
- 8. Projects like: restaurants, shops etc
- 9. Come to the :lesson with positive energy.
- 10. Encourage them to speak through role play
- 11. Play games
- 12. Watch short movies together
- 13. Be a funny teacher
- 14. Give compliments to your pupils
- 15. Use topics, vocabulary and texts that interest your students
