• Give a Student from Your District a Leadership Opportunity
Each district has the opportunity to nominate one student for the NSDA Student Leadership
Council. The SLC was launched in 2022 to create more avenues for student voice in
organizational decision-making and programming. So far this year, the SLC has written for
Rostrum, introduced champion Q&As, and produced new resources. High school students who
will graduate in 2026, 2027, or 2028 can be nominated by coaches in your district through a
standard form until February 15. Chairs receive copies of the nominations via email and must
report their district's nominee by March 1. The NSDA will determine the final SLC in the spring.
