Roles and Responsibilities

This work will be carried out in collaboration with a diverse school, youth, parent and community stakeholder groups and PUSD staff from all levels to inspire positive, sustainable and impactful change in family and community engagement strategies.

An ideal Strategic Plan Steering Committee applicant is someone who

- Wants to build relationships and collective trust across PUSD
- Is committed to expanding collaborative leadership opportunities
- Promotes a warm and caring community environment

What you will be expected to do

- Decide and clarify what the focus is for engagement.
- Reflect on and discuss the best of what is concerning the PUSD's current and past engagement strategies with students, parents, staff and partners.
- Imagine your group, PUSD or community at its best and attempt to identify the common aspirations of whole community members.
- Develop concrete proposals for the new PUSD state of engagement. Often, participants self-select into small groups to develop specific proposals within a specific category.
- Attend and co-lead a community-wide gathering "AI Summit" (with preparation and support)
- Make a self- chosen, personal commitment to take action to support any element of the committee's proposal for engagement.

What you'll receive in return

- Connections with others across the district who share the value of collaboration and community engagement
- The opportunity to participate in the visioning process for engagement in PUSD as part of the broader District Strategic plan for the next five years

How much time you'll spend
