

In 1979, ODFW estimated the statewide black-tailed deer population at 452,000. Population estimates during the next 10 years, based on computer modeling that relied primarily on population parameters collected during field surveys, varied between 400,000 and 500,000. However, in 2004, ODFW estimated the blacktailed deer population for Oregon at 320,000...
