

World Languages Reassessment

The World Languages reassessment policy is focused on holding students accountable for their own learning.

If a student did not achieve the desired learning outcome in a summative assessment and wants to improve, he / she should do the following:

Steps. Sign up for the reassessment by letting your teacher know about your interest to reassess the evaluation of a specific standard.

Policy

- Reassessments take place within a specific period of time specified by the teacher.
- One reassessment is offered to all students for each summative assessment that assesses a particular standard.
- Most recent reassessment evidence enters as a grade into Powerschool.
- There is no reassessment for the **Mid Year Exam** and the **End of Year Exam**.
- If a student is going to miss the reassessment date, he/she is responsible for contacting **the teacher/Administration Office in advance (24h) and providing a justification note, if necessary**. Otherwise, the student may miss the opportunity to reassess.
