After several years without financial support, we are once again reaching out to businesses in Jamaica Plain to sponsor JP Youth Soccer (JPYS). We suspended our local business sponsorship program in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, because we knew local businesses were struggling. Since then, our soccer program serving youth ages 6 ½ to 19 years old has more than doubled in size—we now serve over 650 soccer players from JP and surrounding neighborhoods. With this expanded growth, our costs have also risen, while an increasing number of families request and receive no-questions-asked financial aid from our programs. We need your support to continue to grow and serve our vibrant community of young athletes. For almost 3 decades, thousands of children and teens have been introduced to the sport of soccer, learned to love the game, and more importantly, have gained the experience of self-discipline, teamwork, and benefits of hard work. Your donation will support these efforts for the youth in our community and help continue this important work.

JPYS is committed to welcoming every interested player regardless of ability to pay. Between 25% to 30% of our families seek and receive financial aid every season. Your sponsorship allows us to provide services to many young soccer players who would otherwise be unable to participate. In addition to scholarships, your contribution helps to pay for equipment (JPYS provides practice and game balls, shinguards, goalie gloves, cones, pinnies, first aid kits, ice packs, t-shirt for our in-house programs, and uniforms for those who need them for our players, as well as goals, lights, and port-a-potties that are used by the local community), coach education, insurance, professional coaching support, and league participation fees, as well as entry fees for tournaments. We hope we can count on your support again for the 2025-2026 Fall/Spring season. Below is information on the sponsorship levels.
