Her passion is helping others navigate systems and growing a community of people empowered to heal themselves.

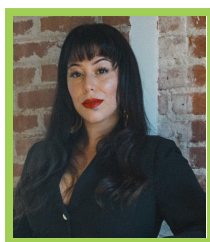
