PI/C report from Area 73 Convention in Huntington (July 2025)

Patrick and Randy H. assisted in taking down the tent and helping pack up and load. It was a successful event. I have a receipt to submit for \$14.00 for candy that was on the table during the event. This was already included in the budget I am submitting today.

District 1 meeting for August 17, 2025

I attended this meeting. Missy S. and Victoria both committed to service work in connection with District 9 for upcoming events. Rosemarie has not been present in some time and Andrea has not responded to the last two messages I sent her about helping.

At this meeting, District 1 agreed to pay half of the cost to order new pamphlets for the rack we have at the AA booth. We had an urgent need to get more of a few of the pamphlets that are significantly important in carrying the message at the upcoming AAPDAC (AA as resource to healthcare professional, About AA, and A Newcomer Asks). The total for 50 of each of these was \$52.47, half of which District 1 agreed to pay. They have a Literature Chairperson and she along with Missy S. already ordered and we received the pamphlets. Can I get a Motion to approve \$26.23 reimbursement to District 1 for this order?

As mentioned, District 1 has agreed to pay half of a larger order for pamphlets and even some swag for the AA booth. I am submitting a budget for expenses, which includes these items. Once approved by our District, Missy S. and District 1's Literature Chairperson, Ashley W., will place the order. We will then reimbursement them for our half of the total cost.
