1. **Homeschool Trial Days:** You can always try out your first class for free! Just come to any existing homeschool class.

Please fill out on the [online waiver](#) ahead of time to help make the check-in process go more smoothly the day of the trial.

2. **Fridays:**

- i. Class from 10-11:00 (\$50 for the whole month of classes)
- ii. Open Gym (OG) from 11-Noon (\$40 for the whole month of OGs)
- iii. Class + OG from 10-Noon (\$70 for the whole month of classes and OGs)

3. **Waiver:**

4. PPK would prefer that first timers take the class before doing Open Gym (OG) only because of safety. Safety comes first. They understand, however, that not everyone will be able to for whatever reason. So, if you can't do BOTH the class and the OG, they will give an initial safety "lecture" at the beginning of the OG. If it turns out that safety becomes an issue, they may need to add on some kind of small fee (\$20?) For the OG only member(s) that need it) to ensure members who are doing OG only know the safety rules, including what he or she can do during OG based on their skill level. The staff thinks they can work around this, but I'm adding it in here just in case.
5. Prices may change the following month depending on the number of participants. The hope is to get many many of homeschoolers so we can help the homeschool community and the gym at the same time. Feedback to PPK this month will be important so they know what our homeschool community needs.
6. There's a really great reason that PPK is not offering a sibling discount. The reason is because the special homeschool membership prices they're giving us are already deeply discounted. If they were going to offer a discounted price for siblings, they would have had to raise the price for the first child to offer the discount. They didn't want to do that.

They wanted to make it as affordable as possible starting with child #1. It's as though the first child is getting a sibling discount too!

7. The homeschool classes are for kids/adults ages 7+. If you have a 6 year old who wants to participate, please bring him or her to the trial day, and PPK coaches will determine whether your child will be able to participate in the classes.
8. PPK classes are usually broken down by ages: 7-11 and 12-16. However, for the homeschool classes, PPK holds one class for all ages. It's been working out great. Different skills can be made easier or more difficult, and the coach will work with your child depending on his or her skill level.
9. The gym has a seating area with windows for those not participating to hang out and watch. There's another room with tables where people not participating (or taking a rest) can hang out, play board games (bring them!), do "home"work, etc.
