God Is On the Move

God is on the move. Baptisms have risen 50% nationally in the past two years, and conversions are up 35% this last year. God has always been moving, and we get to participate; but only if we say yes to God. He does not need your ability, He desires your availability. Read Acts 13:1-5.

God told Abraham to leave his comfort zone and move to an unknown land. Abraham didn't know where he was going, and he didn't know how to get there. But he went because God told him to. God told Moses to go back to Egypt, a place where he was a wanted man. Moses did not want to go, but he believed that God would guide and protect him. Have you ever felt the nudge of God? Has the Holy Spirit ever placed a desire in your heart and mind that you could not ignore? Share with the group how God is moving in your life. Would you go to an unknown land if God asked you to?

Hebrews 11:1-2, 8-9; Colossians 1:9-11

God will move heaven and earth to touch you. He desperately wants to have a relationship with each of us, so much so that He sacrificed His Son so we can live with Him forever. Share any recent miracles you've experienced. How was God's hand revealed in that situation? What is your biggest fear in saying yes to God?

One changed life can affect a lot of people. One person invited by a stranger to church can result in a whole family of ministers, missionaries, and followers of Christ. What does your Christian family tree look like? What is God asking you to say yes to?
