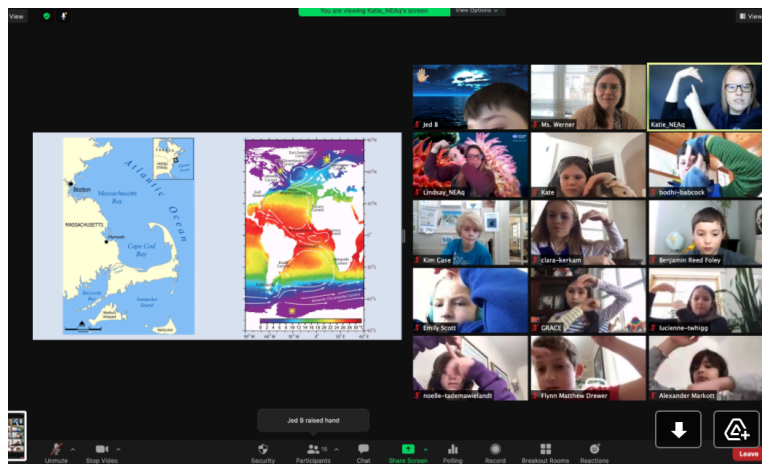


Pond Cove Principal's Notes

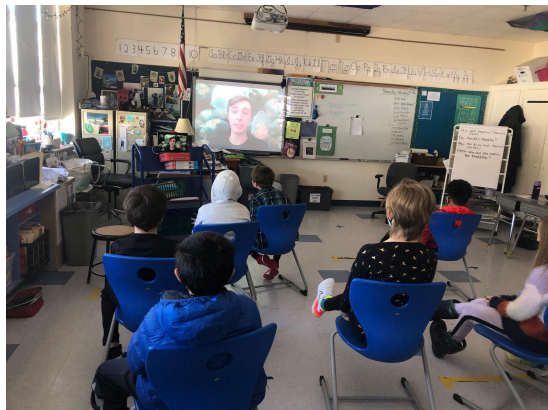
Week of 3/15/2021

Dear Families,

Our Pond Cove Grade 4 students recently participated in a virtual field trip to the New England Aquarium in Boston, MA. During this experience, an aquarium educator presented the inspiring story of Munchkin, a 330 lb sea turtle who was stranded on a beach in Cape Cod, due to cold-stunning, while attempting to migrate south. Munchkin was rescued and admitted to the New England Aquarium's rehabilitation facility in November of 2018. Munchkin's journey led our fourth graders into deep discussions about how we can all be globally and environmentally conscientious citizens! We are very grateful for our friends at CEEF (Cape Elizabeth Education Foundation) for funding this entire experience!

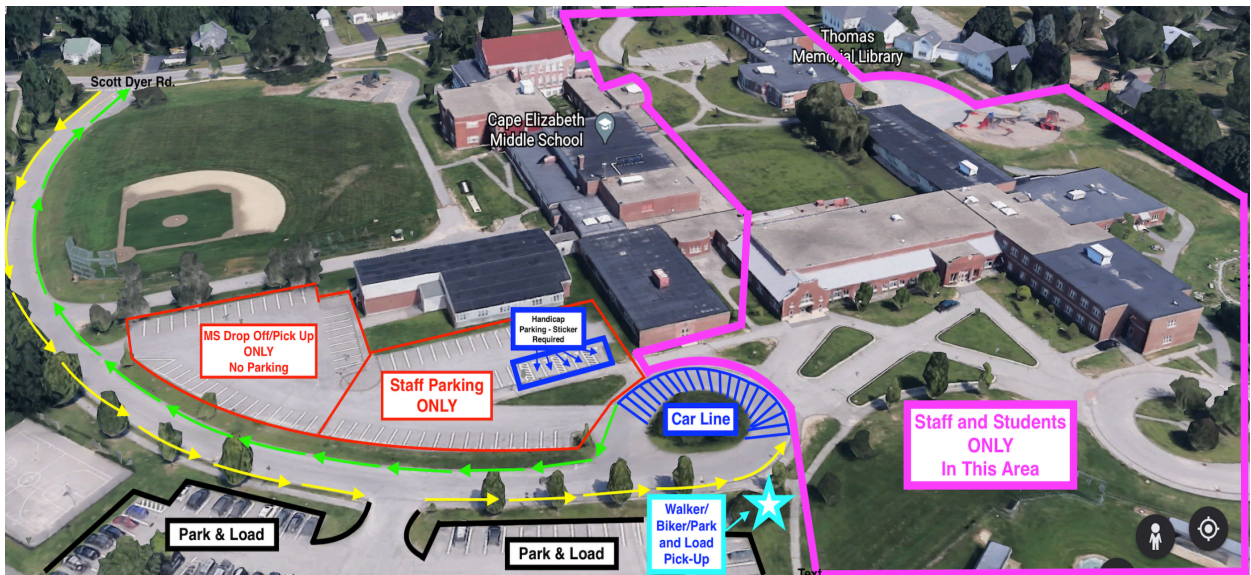
