The City Government of Antipolo, through the **General Fund** intends to apply the sum of **P 18,400,000.00** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **Supply of Fuel through Fleet Card Facility.** Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

The City Government of Antipolo now invites bids for the **Supply of Fuel through Fleet Card Facility.** Contract shall commence upon its execution and shall expire on December 31, 2022. Bidders should have completed, a contract similar to the Project within **2 years** from the date of submission and receipt of bids.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorship, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

Interested bidders may obtain further information from the Procurement Section, City Government of Antipolo and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during **Office Hours (8am – 4 pm).**

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders on **November 29 – December 20, 2021 (until 12:00pm)** from the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of **P 25,000.00**.

The City Government of Antipolo will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **December 6, 2021** at **10:00am**, which shall be open to all interested parties.

Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **December 20, 2021 until 1:00pm**. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount equal to the percentage of the Approved Budget for the Contract in accordance with the form of bid security prescribed herein.

c. Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security.	Five percent (5%)

The Bidder may also submit bid securities in the form of cashier's/manager's check, bank draft/guarantee, or irrevocable letter of credit from other banks certified by the BSP as authorized to issue such financial statement.

Bid opening shall be on **December 20, 2021** at **2:00pm**. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

The City Government of Antipolo reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
