MATH TIPS	READING TIPS
<p>Tips for knowing and memorizing addition and subtraction facts.</p> <p>+ - + - + - + - + - +</p> <p>How can parents help?</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Understand that addition means putting together to find a sum and that subtraction means taking away to find the difference.2. Know the doubles facts for addition and subtraction. Then, your child can add one or take away one to get another fact.3. Know the addition/subtraction facts up to 20. Knowing the fact families will help too.4. When adding, learn to count on from the biggest number.5. When subtracting, count back if it is a small number. Example-10-2 would be 9 and then 8. So, $10-2=8$6. Count up if it is a bigger number. Example-10-6 would be 7,8,9,10 so $10-6=4$ because it took four numbers to count to 10.	<p>Phonemic awareness is the ability to identify and manipulate individual sounds in spoken words. This is a key to literacy development and will help with decoding words and fluency.</p> <p>How can parents help?</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Read and re-read books as often as you can.2. Talk about letter and sounds. Say rhyming words.3. Break apart words(segment) and put together(blend). This can help with spelling, writing, and with decoding words. Identify the sounds at the beginning, middle, and end of a word.4. Practice word families(rhyming)or word games. Example-change the c in cat to h. You would then have hat. This can be done at the beginning, middle, or end of a word.

7. Practice facts until mastered.

$$4+4=8 \text{ so } 8-4=4$$
