## Instructions

- 1. Navigate to dartgo.org/envs7-02 and click on the Class Activity Links tab on the left hand side.
- 2. Open the Resource Comparison Google Sheet document and navigate to the tab on the bottom of the sheet for **Web of Science**
- 3. Click on the link for **Web of Science** in Cell A2
- 4. Type or copy paste the following search phrase into the search box: *gender and conservation*
- 5. Answer the following questions based on your results and add them to the google sheet:
  - a. How many search results did you get?
  - b. What form did the results take? (i.e. papers from journals, news articles, theses or dissertations, books, videos, audio clips, etc.)
  - c. How relevant are the results overall?
  - d. In general, where are the keywords occurring in the search results? (i.e. in the title, abstract, publication title, etc.)
  - e. How do you get to the full-text of the articles?
  - f. What options do you have to filter or sort your results?
