Columbarium Rules

- 1. The Rector / Priest-in-Charge will perform all interment services of ashes into the columbarium. Please speak with the Rector/PIC before making any arrangements.
- 2. Each niche can hold the ashes for two individuals. They can be obtained for single or double use and measure approximately 12 x 12 x 12.
- 3. To maintain uniformity the nameplates will be ordered and installed by the Church of the Mediator but paid for by the family or estate of the person to be interred. The nameplate will read

Name Date of Birth -- Date of Death

- 4. The Church of the Mediator will maintain a directory of the niche location and the date of interment for the columbarium.
- 5. Active members of the Church of the Mediator will not be charged for interment. A donation to the church will be appreciated.
- Inactive members or persons not members of the Church of the Mediator will be charged \$800 for the interment per niche.
 The fee may be updated annually at the discretion of the Rector/PIC and the vestry.
- It is customary for two arrangements of flowers to be placed behind the altar for a funeral or memorial service. Flowers are the responsibility of the family.
- 8. Nothing is to be placed on top of the columbarium. Occasionally a small flower arrangement may be placed on a small table by the Paschal Candle and columbarium at the discretion of the Rector/PIC.
