








# Smile Club Assembly on September 18, 2023




## Covid strain XBB.1.16

Or 'Arctrus' is a subspecies of the omicron strain of COVID monitored by the World Health Organization.

This species have high potential risk with 200% more contagious than the main strain in Thailand, BN.1.3, and 89% higher than XBB.1.5 (the main omicron strain in Thailand).





## stay away from influenza

Influenza is a disease that spreads from person to person. It happens every year caused by influenza virus that causes infections in the respiratory tract such as the nose, throat, trachea and lungs. The virus spreads out to the lungs until it can cause pneumonia.

Most outbreaks were found during the rainy season and winter.

### How to prevent influenza infection

- Annual influenza vaccination. It's the best way to prevent flu virus.
- Avoid being in close contact with people who have influenza symptoms. Avoid going in public places during an outbreak.
- Patients and caregivers must wear a surgical mask at all times. (especially when coughing/sneezing)
- Get in the habit of washing your hands or cleaning your hands with alcohol gel especially after coughing or sneezing or touching items in public places and after removing the hygienic mask.
- Dispose the used tissues after wiping snot, saliva, or used masks into a closed bin.
- Avoid rubbing your eyes with your hands or using your fingers to pick your nose because it is
  a channel that allows germs to enter the body easily.
- Do not share personal belongings with others such as glasses, drinking straws, cutlery, hand towels or handkerchiefs.
- Use a serving spoon when eating with other people.

Cover your mouth when you cough or sneeze with tissue or the inside of your elbow

Make sure your mask fits well with the nose clip

Parents/visitors who wish to enter campus are asked to schedule an appointment through the registrar.
