- Use Goodreads, etc, for more recommendations

How to get your book:

- Get it at the AHS Media Center (check out library catalog for availability)
- Download the e-book or audiobook through Sora
- Request through Robbins Library or Boston Public Library (print book for pickup, Libby, or Hoopla)
- Purchase it on your own at the <u>Book Rack</u> or bookstore of your choice, borrow from a friend, etc.
