 3. This month's business:
 - a. Wellness Report - Phena Brown - Phena Brown - presented the policy on student and employee wellness - gave a copy for each member of the council - talked about the different types of offerings at the school that increase student wellness - like PE, aerobic conditioning, dance, and intramurals. An area of improvement could be to consider healthier options as rewards - some examples could be pencils, little ducks, etc. The end of term rewards are something activity based which really is great for wellness - the vending machines do have healthy options.  - b. Counselor Report - Troy Andersen
 - i. Sources of Strength - - next lesson for 6th grade is on emotional regulation. 7th grade talked most recently about generosity - and the students created Valentines for students in California who lost their school. Next lesson will be focused on mental health and how to stay mentally healthy.
 - ii. CCRPs - Talked about YouScience aptitude test that the students take to match students interests with their aptitude.
 - iii. Registration - talked through the process for 6th graders who are all mostly taken care of - tomorrow 7th grade students will get their registration materials.
 - iv. Sharp Survey - All 6th graders who parents gave permission at registration
 - c. Academic Performance Report: Our academic performance improved in some areas, not in others. In comparison from May 2023 to May 2024 RISE test scores. The results are as follows. The numbers are reflective of those students who were proficient on the test. For example, an increase of 3% means 3% more of students were proficient meaning 54% were proficient in May 2023 and 57% of students were proficient in May 2024.
 - 6th grade language arts - decreased 3%
 - 7th grade language arts - increased 2%

6th grade math - decreased 2%
7th grade math - increased 3%
6th grade science - increased 3%
7th grade science - decreased 1%
