 - Pressure from LACOE about diversity: need 60% Latinoneed more outreach to recruit

 - ASB is waiting on prom contracts
 - Grad night is waitlisted for Disney

 - Bell schedule survey- please fill it out. It was emailed by Brendan
 - Jonelle mentioned a big barrier she's seeing regarding increasing diversity: transportation to/from LACHSA. Will there be busing in underserved communities? We have TAP cards, but not all parents are comfortable with their kids taking public transportation. Dr. V suggests writing a letter to the board. Board info can be found here. The admin is already advocating for buses. Daryl mentioned that pre-Covid, public transportation was a big part of LACSHA's culture.
 - What's driving the change for the bell schedule? -we have to move to a 6th period day legally- it's a CDC decision.
 The scheduling issue is making sure all 6 classes have the same amount of teaching time
 - Alex- how are we leveraging outreach to community based organizations for outreach instead of LACHSA doing all of the outreach? The priority has been outreach to organizations that have a connection to the arts, but with less resources: master classes, presentations,. We're not reaching all of LA County because of our capacity. We are also reaching out to arts teachers, Additionally they ask in admissions how they heard of LACHSA. This data is important so we know who is getting our message and who isn't.. Versastyle could be a resource (rec from Dani). Hilary- Is LACOE helping with any outreach? They advertised an immersion program on their trucks, this helped get the word out.
