On this date: November 21st:

1620 - On this day in 1620, 41 male passengers on the Mayflower, prior to landing at Plymouth, Massachusetts, signed the Mayflower Compact, by which they agreed to abide by the laws of the new government they would establish.

Native American and Alaska Native Heritage Moment of the Day - Today, we highlight Inupiat Eskimo, Howard Rock. Howard Rock helped prevent the Atomic Energy Commission from performing above-ground nuclear tests in a harbor near his village and helped lead the Native land claims struggle, which led to the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act.
