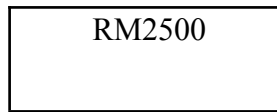

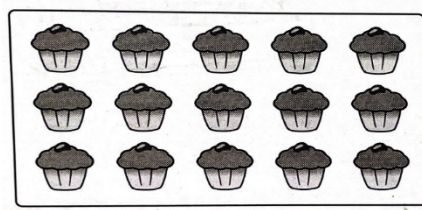
- (b) The diagram shows the number of cupcakes that sold by Puan Mary in three months.
