In fact, Putin's regime, as did Stalin's, cynically denies the very existence of the Ukrainian nation and attempts to eliminate Ukrainian national identity through terrible war crimes, mass deportations, forcible transfer of Ukrainian children, and brutal assimilation in the Russian-occupied territories.

Russia's unilateral decision to suspend the Black Sea Grain Initiative and its blockade of Ukrainian seaports, which led to the disruption of global food supply chains, also clearly show that after 90 years, Moscow is once again weaponizing food and starvation.

While the war of Russian aggression against Ukraine is indeed genocide, Russian aggression 90 years ago must also be recognized as genocide. Your designation of the Holodomor as genocide would be a powerful step towards historical justice and truth.
