Developing a Broad Goal Statement and Supporting Objectives for Each Goal Area

On April 18, 2023 Bloomfield Public Schools parents, board members, staff, administration, and community members came together to continue the strategic planning process. The third and final meeting's topic focused on the development of a broad goal statement and four or so supporting objectives for each of the goal areas. These goals will represent a shared vision for Bloomfield Public Schools over the next five years.

After welcoming remarks from Sal Goncalves, Charlene Peterson from New Jersey School Boards Association facilitated the strategic planning process. The group was provided with an overview of the March 2 and March 28 meetings and then the goal writing process was introduced that included the connection to the work from the first two meetings and the components of a goal statement.

Participants were divided into five breakout groups – one group per each goal area:

- Student Success
- Staff Success
- Operations
- Culture & Climate
- Family and Community Connections

Each goal area group was tasked with writing a broad goal statement and developing accompanying objectives that reflected the strengths, challenges, and visions relative to their goal area as determined in Meetings 1 and 2.
