

Hello Scout Family you are receiving this because your scout has shown interest in attending summer camp this year. While it is a while off and may be hard to commit at this point there are financial benefits in doing so, and deadlines that need to be met to ensure there is a spot for your scout at camp.

This year the scouts have decided to attend Massawepie Scout Camp (65 Massawepie Rd., Tupper Lake, NY 12986) in the Adirondacks, this will be a great experience for all scouts, giving them the opportunity to enjoy all the beauty of the Adirondacks has to offer while earning merit badges to help them advance on their scouting journey.

The Troop is registered to attend the third session **07/19/2026- 07/25/2026**

The Cost for each Scout to attend is **\$600.00** if paid in full by **04/21/2026**. We ask that you **pay a \$100 deposit by March 27th**.

- **\$100.00** deposit per scout due by **03/27th** to hold their spot
- With the increased cost of camp this year the troop committee has agreed to give each scout **\$100.00** towards camp if paid in full by **April 21th**, balance due after \$100 deposit and \$100 troop subsidy will be **\$400.00**.
- If you do not make the Early Bird Deadline camp will cost **\$660.00** if paid by **05/25**
- If you do not make the payment by that deadline, camp will cost **\$700.00**

Your Scout can use funds from their account towards camp as well, if you would like to use those funds please check the box at the bottom of this form and we will provide you with their balance.

Your Scout will not be registered for camp until paid in full

If you are an Adult interested in going your cost would be \$200.00 which would need to be received by April 15th. If you plan on attending please let your scout's leader know as there are other requirements for adults to attend camp.

To attend camp each Scout and Adult will need to provide

- This signed contract along with the first payment
- A completed Medical Form Parts A-C to be turned in by June 13th (Don't worry we will send reminders). These forms need to be filled out and signed by the doctor so please plan accordingly
- A meningococcal meningitis vaccination response form (June 13th Deadline)
- A medication permission form (June 13th Deadline)
- If necessary, a camp food accommodation request has an email address on the form for you to provide directly to the camp and must be done by 07/01/2025. If you would like us to submit that we need it by June 13th as well.
- There may be other required forms moving forward so please check all correspondence

I have reviewed the above information and would like my scout to attend summer camp. I understand that by signing this form I am agreeing that my scout will attend camp and that I am responsible for all monies due whether they attend or not.

Cancellation Policy:

Cancel within 60 days of making a registration and the entire amount is returned. After 60 days of making a registration but not within 30 days of the event, the customer is charged 75% of the registration cost being canceled. Once within 30 days of the event, the customer is charged 100% of the registration cost being canceled.
