Parents/Visitors: During matches, the moderator, scorekeeper, participating players, and coaches are allowed to be in the room. If a match has already begun, please refrain from entering the room, as it can distract players.

Basic snacks and lunch will be provided, however, if students want extras they will need to bring cash as our PTA will be selling some other delicious goodies.

Tournament Seeding: Ranking from prelims will count and determine your placing in the single-elimination tournament rounds starting from the Round of 16. Your place in the tournament will be determined by the wins/losses from the prelims as the first criterion. If the winning percentage is the same, the team with the most wins will have the higher rank. If there is a tie, the Total Average Points per Tossup Heard (PPTH) of all the games played during the prelims will be used to determine rankings in the tournament as the second criterion.

Tie-Breakers: If the score is tied, an off-the-clock overtime period consisting of three tossup questions will follow. These tossup questions are scored as normal (including power points and interrupt penalties). Bonus questions are not used in overtime. These tossups will be read from the original set (if unread tossups remain) or may be obtained from the tournament director. If the score is still tied after three tossups, the moderator will read tossup questions until the score changes. These tossups will be read from the original set (if unread tossups remain) or may be obtained from the tournament director.



Protests: The moderator is solely responsible for determining what players said (or did not say) and ruling thereon. Such determinations cannot be protested. The moderator may seek opinions from other game officials (if a possible issue is raised informally), but the final decision lies with the moderator. Protests may only be lodged by the official coach or by an active player when the alleged error occurred. All protests must be made within 5 minutes of the end of the game and before the protesting team leaves the game room.
