Spanish 1

This course provides the student with a basis for learning Spanish as it is spoken and written today. Major emphasis is given to developing the student's basic language skills - listening comprehension, speaking, reading, and writing. Vocabulary and grammar instruction will enable the students to use the language in meaningful ways. The student will learn about the Spanish-speaking world -- its people and its culture.

Spanish 1101

Spanish 1101 is an introduction to the fundamentals of the Spanish language with practice in listening, reading, speaking and writing. Course includes selected studies in Hispanic culture. A fast pace semester class allows you to receive dual credit (1 year of HS credit and 4 credits at Columbus State). Each unit deals with multiple grammar points, a thematic vocabulary piece, and many nuanced language difference between English and Spanish. The course is challenging and requires you to push yourself to complete all assignments, and you need a 75% to be able to take the next course at CSCC.

Spanish 1102

This course is a continuation of Spanish 1101, with further development of listening, reading, speaking and writing skills and further study of Hispanic culture. A fast pace semester class allows you to receive dual credit (1 year of HS credit and 4 credits at Columbus State). Each unit deals with multiple grammar points, a thematic vocabulary piece, and many nuanced language difference between English and Spanish. The course is challenging and requires you to push yourself to complete all assignments, and you need a 75% to be able to take the next course at CSCC.
