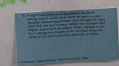

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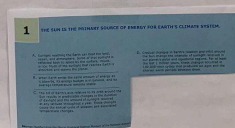
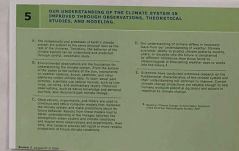
- increased temps, drought, flood, fire

8. Hope and Urgency

8. Hope & Urgency

- Where to get help
 - How to take action
 - Hard data/context of what the problem is
 - How is community affected?
 - What actions already happening locally & timeline it would take to see change
 - Validating emotions → it is OK to be afraid
 - Have a positive/personal connection to the environment
 - * ancestral knowledge
 - * loss of practices
 - Identify costs & benefits of changes
 - Current legislation and party policy
- lots of research on dairy emission reduction
