1. Tie Dye-Versity!

- Tie Dyeing shirts to learn about diversity and promoting diversity on the McKendree campus
- Materials Needed: plain white t-shirts, tie dye, maybe hand out the “Gender and Sexuality Terms You Should Know” brochure
- *Also maybe have students bring their own items that they would like to tie dye

2. Bulletin Board about diversity

 - ii. Materials needed: colored construction paper, writing utensils, scissors, string for the tea bags

3. Bulletin Board of the “Genderbread Person”

- a. Materials needed: colored construction paper, writing utensils, scissors

4. “Think Before You Speak” bulletin board

- a. This stresses the importance of not using the phrase “That’s So Gay”
 - i. **T.H.I.N.K.:** Is it **TRUE?** Is it **HELPFUL?** Is it **INSPIRING?** Is it **NECESSARY?** Is it **KIND?**
 - ii. Materials needed: colored construction paper, writing utensils, scissors

5. LGBT Alphabet Soup Bulletin Board

- a. A bowl of soup with the letters “LGBTQIA” and then each letter explains the definition of word and the importance. This could also possibly tie in with the “Gender and Sexuality Terms to Know” brochure
