

PENN RESOURCES FOR ENTREPRENEURS

Penn Med-Wharton Fund for Health

- **Description:** \$100-250K funding for startups that demonstrate the possibility of – and commitment to – positive impact in Philadelphia working on social determinants of health
- **Eligibility:** Must have lead investor secured, must be based in Philly or have large proportion of customers in Philly, must NOT be associated with Penn due to conflict of interest
- **Timing:** Ongoing

Penn Wharton Innovation Fund

- **Description:** \$500-5000K funding for early-stage ventures founded and led by one or more Penn students
- **Eligibility:** Must be a new venture founded while the team lead and/or team members are currently Penn students and have not received more than \$150k in institutional funding
- **Timing:** Ongoing

Penn Carey Law Entrepreneurship Legal Clinic

- **Description:** Pro bono transactional legal service to Philadelphia area entrepreneurs and businesses
- **Eligibility:** Give preference to ventures that impact society and communities in positive ways because have limited capacity
- **Timing:** Accept application 2x/year - spring and fall
- **StartUp Kit:** Provides free legal resources for startups, including founders' agreements, IP guidance, and financing information

Entrepreneur-in-residence (EIR) program

- **Description:** Opportunity for entrepreneurs to serve as mentors and advisors to folks in the community
