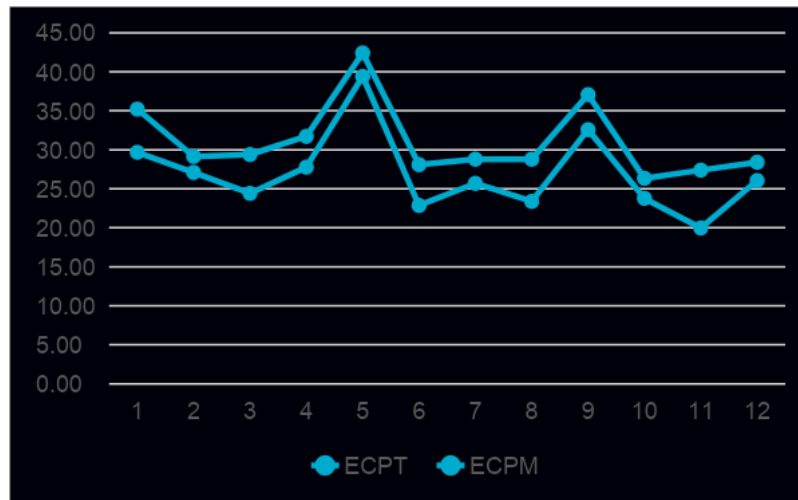


Figure 1. ECPT and ECPM, This is the example for figure formatting
