B: "Funny you should mention the gunner."

(Switch to the tune of "Sir Patrick Spens")
For the gunner was with Sir Patrick Spens
When he came o'er the Sea
And with them was Queen Eleanor
And also King Henry.

(Switch to the tune of "Queen Eleanor's Confession")

Queen Eleanor was a sick woman And afraid that she would die ...

B: "But that's not part of this story."

M: "Speaking of sick women though ..."

B: "Oh dear."

(Switch back to the tune of "Matty Groves")

The very first shot that he did shoot It hurt young Matty sore And Janet climbed aboard the ship A stomping on the floor.

(Switch to the tune of "King Henry")

Some meat, some meat,

Ye King Henry

Some meat ya'll bring ta me,

Go and skin the great Selkie

And bring his meat to me!

B: "Ewwww!"

M: "I did mention the sick women?"

(Switch back to the tune of "Queen Eleanor's Confession")
The very first shot King Henry shot
It hurt the gunner sore
And then Matty shot a bunch more times
Just to make quite sure.

And Janet did as much for him As any widow may She'll sit and weep upon his grave For twelvemonth and a day

(Switch to the tune of "All Around My Hat")

And all around her hat she will wear the green willow

All around her hat while she's sitting on her duff

And if anyone should ask her the reason why she's wearing it

"It's because I'm in a ballad, and it's gone on long enough!"
