Jehovah Jesus - Who is Who

Isa 43:10 Ye *are* my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I *am* he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.

NWT Isa 43:10 You are my witnesses is the utterance of Jehovah, even my servant whom I have chosen, in order that you may know and have faith in me and that you may understand that I am the same One. Before me there was no God formed, and after me there continued to be none.

Isa 45:5 I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me:

NWT Isa 45:5 I am Jehovah and there is no one else. With the exception of me, there is no God. I shall closely gird you, although you have not known me. Isa 45:6 That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that *there is* none beside me. I *am* the LORD, and *there is* none else.

NWT Isa 45:6 In order that people may know from the rising of the sun and its setting that there is none besides me. I am Jehovah and there is no one else.

#1. There is no other God besides Jehovah, correct?

Isa 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else.

NWT 45:18 For this is what Jehovah has said: the creator of the heavens, He, the True God, the Former of the earth and the maker of it; He, the One who firmly established it established it, who did not create it simply for nothing, who formed it even to be inhabited: I *am* Jehovah; and *there is* no one else. Isa 44:24 Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I *am* the LORD that maketh all *things*; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

NWT Isa 44:24 This is what Jehovah has said, your Repurchaser and the Former of you from the belly: "I Jehovah, am doing everything, stretching out the heavens by myself, laying out the earth, Who was with me? #2. Jehovah is the only Creator. He was alone when everything was created, correct?

Isa 43:11 I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no savior.

NWT Isa 43:11 I am Jehovah; and besides me there is no savior.

Isa 45:21 Tell ye, and bring *them* near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? *who* hath told it from that time? *have* not I the LORD? and *there is* no God else beside me; a just God and a Savior; *there is* none beside me.

NWT Isa 45:21 Make your report and your presentation. Yes, let them consult together in unity. Who has caused this to be heard from a long time ago? Who has reported it from that very time? Is it not I, Jehovah, besides whom there is no other God; a righteous God and a Savior, there being none except me?

#3. Jehovah is the one and only Savior, correct?

Isa 44:6 Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me *there is* no God. NWT Isa 44:6 This is what Jehovah has said, the King of Israel and the Repurchaser of him, Jehovah of armies, I am the 1st and I am the last, and besides me, there is no God. 41:4 Who hath wrought and done *it*, calling the generations from the beginning? I the LORD, the first, and with the last; I am he. NWT 41:4 Who has been active and has done this, calling out the generations from the start? I, Jehovah, the First One, and with the last ones I am the same. Rev 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty. NWT Rev 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, says Jehovah God, the One who is and who was and is coming, the Almighty.

#4. Jehovah is the King of Israel, the First and the Last, the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end, correct?

Deu 32:3-4 Because I will publish the name of the LORD: ascribe ye greatness unto our God. *He is* the Rock, his work *is* perfect: for all his ways *are* judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right *is* he. Psa 18:31 For who is God, but the LORD? And who is a rock, except our God? NWT Deu 32:3-4 For I shall declare the name of Jehovah. Do you attribute greatness to our God! The Rock, perfect is his activity, For all his ways are justice. Righteous and upright is he. #5. Jehovah is the only Rock, correct?

Isa 33:22 For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; he will save us.

NWT Isa For Jehovah is our Judge, Jehovah is our Statutegiver, Jehovah is our King; he himself will save us. #6. Jehovah is our Judge and King, correct?

Isa 42:8 I am the LORD: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.

NWT Isa 42:8 I am Jehovah: That is my name: and to no one else will give my own glory, neither my praise to graven images.

Isa 48:11 For mine own sake, *even* for mine own sake, will I do *it*: for how should *my name* be polluted? and I will not give my glory unto another. NWT Isa 48:11 For mine own sake, for mine own sake, I shall act, for how could one let one self be profaned? And to no one else shall I give my own glory.

#7. Jehovah will not give his glory to anyone, correct?

#1. Jehovah is the one and only God. #2. Jehovah is the one and only Creator and He was alone when everything was created. #3. Jehovah is the one and only Savior. #4. Jehovah is the King of Israel, the First and the Last, the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. #5. Jehovah is the only Rock. #6. Jehovah is our Judge and King. #7. Jehovah will not share His glory with anyone.

If any one declared that they possessed even one of these characteristics distinct to Jehovah alone, would it not be considered blasphemy? (John 10:33)

Isa 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

NWT Isa 9:6 For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us: and the princely rule will come to be on his shoulder: and his name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. #1. Jesus is not "a" Mighty God, but "Mighty" God, correct?

Isa 10:20-21 In that day the remnant of Israel and the survivors of the house of Jacob will no more lean on him who struck them, but will lean on the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. A remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, to the mighty God.

NWT Isa 10:20-21 And it will certainly occur in that day that those remaining over of Israel and those who have escaped of the house of Jacob will will never again support themselves upon the one striking them, and they will certainly support themselves upon Jehovah, the Holy One of Israel, in trueness. A mere remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, to the Mighty God. Who is "the Mighty God"? According to Isa 9:6, Jesus is Eternal Father, correct? In the new testament, "Father" refers to Jehovah all 271 times. But here, Jesus is called Eternal Father. Jesus had no children; what was He Father of? Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

NWT Joh 1:1 In the beginning the Word was, and the Word was with God, and the Word was a God. The original Greek scriptures do not include the word "a". Jesus is the Word, and therefore Jesus is God; definite article. However, Jesus is merely "a god" in the NWT.

Joh 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, & dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. NWT Joh 1:14 So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only begotten son from a father. And he was full of undeserved kindness and truth.

Joh 1:2-3 The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

NWT This one was in the beginning with God. All things came into existence through him, and apart from him not even one thing came into existence.

#2. Jesus is the Creator, correct?

Tit 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ

NWT Tit 2:13 While we wait for the happy hope and glorious manifestation of the great God and of the Savior of us, Christ Jesus

In the original Greek in this scripture, the second 'of the', and 'of us' is not present.

Act 4:10-12 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, *even* by him doth this man stand here before you whole. This is the stone which was set at naught of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. NWT Act 4:10-12 Let it be known to all of YOU and to all the people of Israel, that in the name of Jesus Christ the Naz-a-rene', whom YOU impaled but whom God raised up from the dead, by this one does this man stand here sound in front of YOU. This is 'the stone that was treated by YOU builders as of no account that has become the head of the corner.' Furthermore, there is no salvation in anyone else, for there is not another name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must get saved."

#3. Jesus is the one and only Savior, correct?

Joh 1:49 Nathanael answered and saith unto him, Rabbi, thou art the Son of God; thou art the King of Israel.

NWT Joh 1:49 Na than a el answered him: "Rabbi, you are the Son of God, you are King of Israel."

Rev 1:17-18 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last: I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive forevermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

NWT Rev 1:17-18 And when I saw him, I fell as dead at his feet. And he laid his right hand upon me and said: "Do not be fearful. I am the First and the Last, and the living one; and I became dead, but, look! I am living forever and ever, and I have the keys of death and of Ha'des.

KJV Rev 22:13 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

NWT Rev 22:13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end. Only one person can be the first or the last in anything.

#4. Jesus is the King of Israel, First and the Last, Alpha and the Omega, Beginning and the End, correct?

1Co 10:1-4 Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; And did all eat the same spiritual meat; And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

NWT Now I do not want YOU to be ignorant, brothers, that our forefathers were all under the cloud and all passed through the sea and all got baptized into Moses by means of the cloud and of the sea; and all ate the same spiritual food and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they used to drink from the spiritual rock-mass that followed them, and that rock-mass meant the Christ. The word "meant" should read "was".

#5. Jesus is the Rock, correct?

Rev 19:11-16 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes *were* as a flame of fire, and on his head *were* many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

NWT Rev 19:11-16 And I saw the heaven opened, and, look! a white horse. And the one seated upon it is called Faithful and True, and he judges and carries on war in righteousness. His eyes are a fiery flame, and upon his head are many diadems. He has a name written that no one knows but he himself, and he is arrayed with an outer garment sprinkled with blood, and the name he is called is The Word of God. Also, the armies that were in heaven were following him on white horses, and they were clothed in white, clean, fine linen. And out of his mouth there protrudes a sharp long sword, that he may strike the nations with it, and he will shepherd them with a rod of iron. He treads too the winepress of the anger of the wrath of God the Almighty. And upon his outer garment, even upon his thigh, he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords.

#6. Jesus is our Judge and King, correct?

Mat 16:27 For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.

NWT For the Son of man is destined to come in the glory of his Father with his angels, and then he will recompense each one according to his behavior.

Joh 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was. NWT So now you, Father, glorify me alongside yourself with the glory that I had alongside you before the world was.

#7. Jesus shares the Father's glory, correct?

- #1. Jehovah and Jesus are the one and only God.
- #2. Jehovah and Jesus are the one and only Creator and They existed alone before everything was created.
- #3. Jehovah and Jesus are the one and only Savior.
- #4. Jehovah and Jesus are the King of Israel, the First and the Last, the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End.
- #5. Jehovah and Jesus are the only Rock.
- #6. Jehovah and Jesus are our Judge and King.
- #7. Jehovah and Jesus will not share Their glory with anyone.

The KJV and NWT Scriptures both declare unashamedly that Jesus possesses not only one or two characteristics distinct to Jehovah alone, He possesses all 7. Jesus and Jehovah are one harmony of Divine character and authority; one Spirit. Both are equally God and Creator; there is no other. All others are created. Only God who created all could make a sacrifice for all. While on earth, Jesus never once exercised His divinity to serve Himself. Only the Father exercised divinity through His Son in proportion to Jesus' faith. Jesus proved that even with unlimited power at His fingertips, God in His creature's body and predicament is faithfully submissive to selflessness, void of all selfishness, even unto death. This is the best way possible for sin and rebellion to never rise again for eternity future throughout the ceaseless ages. God has proven His love and His selflessness in an astounding fashion. Psa 18:31,46 For who is God save the LORD? or who is a rock save our God? The LORD liveth; and blessed be my rock; and let the God of my salvation be exalted.
