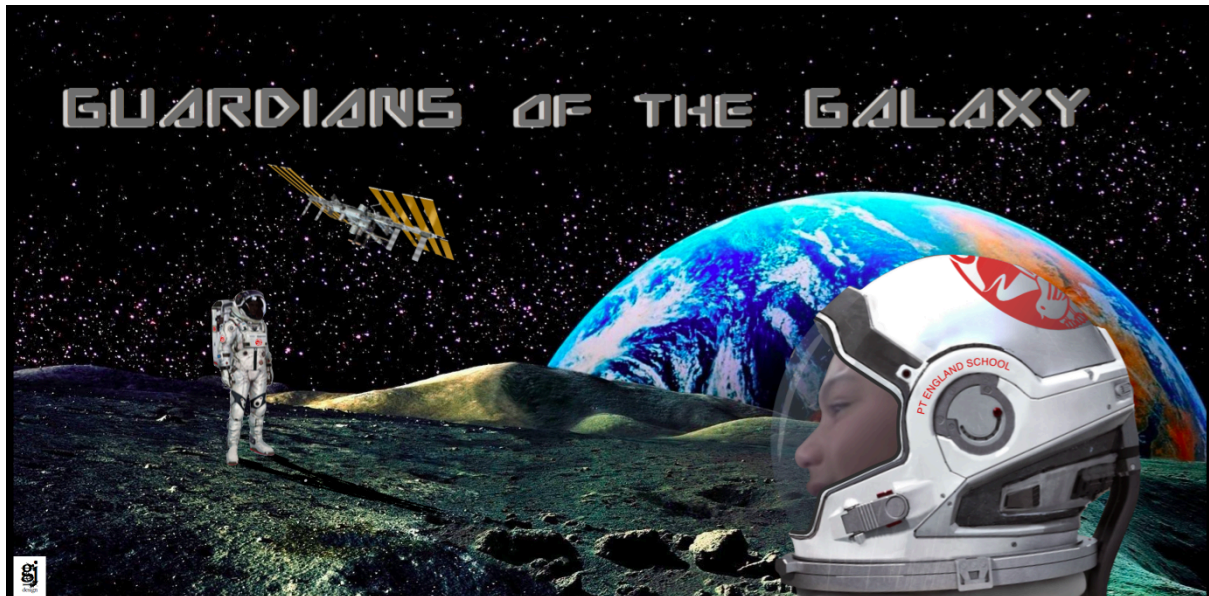


Animation Writing and Voice Over



Walt be thoughtful about links between oral (spoken), written, and visual language to give purpose to our writing.
