To encourage our students to keep reading great books over the summer months, we here at the Maplewood Middle School library offer a summer check out program. We allow current Maplewood students in good standing the opportunity to check out books for the summer. Interested? Here is how it works:

- You must return or pay for any library books you still have checked out before you can checkout any summer books. *(even if the books are from your previous Menasha school)*
- Students can choose up to 10 books
- During the weeks of May 16-27 students may check out books to take home for the summer.
- Read, Read and read some more (this is the FUN part)
- Return books by Friday, September 2nd, 2016.
- All students have access to free ebooks and audiobooks through Overdrive all summer. <http://mjsd.lib.overdrive.com>

INSTRUCTIONS FOR RETURNING YOUR BOOKS

- Before getting ready to return your books, check your book list to make sure ALL the books you checked out in May/June are accounted for. If a cloth bag was provided, you must also return the bag.
- Please return all books to any Menasha school library by Friday, September 2nd. Books can be returned to the Clovis Elementary or Menasha High School libraries during summer school hours.
- DO NOT RETURN YOUR BOOKS DURING REGISTRATION
- Any missing/damaged books will need to be paid for. Your WILL NOT be able to check books out in the fall until the books are returned and/or missing/damaged books are paid for.
- **IF YOU MOVE during the summer** please return books to the school office. If the school office is not open you can place them in the Menasha Public Library return bin.
