# **How to Start a Constillate Chapter**

A step-by-step guide to launching your own club in your school or community

### **Step 1: Read the Requirements**

Make sure you meet these before applying:

- You're between ages 13-22
- You have at least 2 people interested in forming a chapter
- You agree to follow Constillate's mission and values
- You understand the chapter must include our logo and follow our branding guidelines

### Step 2: Reach Out to Us

Email us at **admin@constillate.org** with the subject line: "Inquiry About Starting a Chapter"

In your email, include:

- Your name, age, city, and school/organization (if any)
- Why you want to start a chapter
- How many people are interested
- Any ideas you already have for events or activities

## Step 3: Get Approved

Once we review your email, we'll schedule a short virtual meeting to go over:

- What Constillate does
- What's in the Chapter Toolkit
- How we can support you

After that, you'll get an official chapter approval email and toolkit.

#### Step 4: Set Up Your Chapter

Once approved:

- Start looking for admin members
- The president & vice president will have an official domain email. I.E <a href="Memphis@constillate.org">Memphis@constillate.org</a>. You can create other emails using <a href="mailto:gmail.com">gmail.com</a>
- Design your logo (must include the official Constillate logo)

#### **Step 5: Promote and Recruit**

- Announce your new chapter online or at school
- Use our templates for flyers and graphics
- Recruit members and start planning activities

#### Step 6: Check In With Us

- Keep in touch at least once a month via email or check-in form
- Send updates, photos, or flyers so we can support and promote your work
- You'll also be invited to quarterly calls or trainings
