PRESSING ISSUES

- 1. MIIP insurance increases enrollment ends May 13 FAQ sheet developed to address concerns CRCSD is now the heaviest user of the six entities, and was assessed a 15% increase on top of the 11% across the board, minus a 6% differential OPEN ENROLLMENT period is the time to make any necessary changes (ends May 13)
- 2. Course Approvals/Level Changes information expense of lane changes have resulted in tightening of procedures for approval Executive Director of Human Resources will not grant full credit for some online courses, citing lack of rigor an approved list of courses is being developed CR is one of few districts that will recognize recertification credits on the salary schedule ISEA courses have proven rigor and are considered acceptable, but still need to follow course approval process Principals will approve courses that align with teaching assignment Approval will be emailed If a course is not approved, teachers can request a meeting with Jill Cirivello, HR director

- **3. Staffing** is mostly finished, with most requests honored 2.7 RIF notices were issued our contract DOES NOT have voluntary surplus unless there is a significant change of assignment of program (ie: magnet school or alternative calendar)
- **4. CROTA** bargaining still in process increased health insurance premiums are a hardship for many paras
