Taylor prints this separately referencing B20933; I do the same to allow it to have its own link for ease of reference.

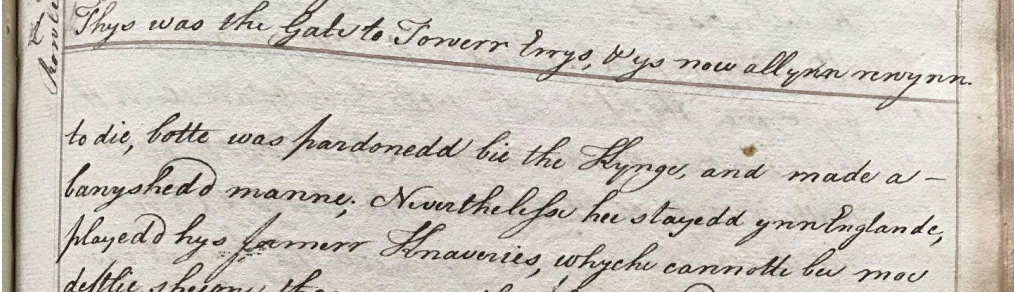

The last line on the page is missing on at least two of Catcott's pages - probably the fault of the binder.

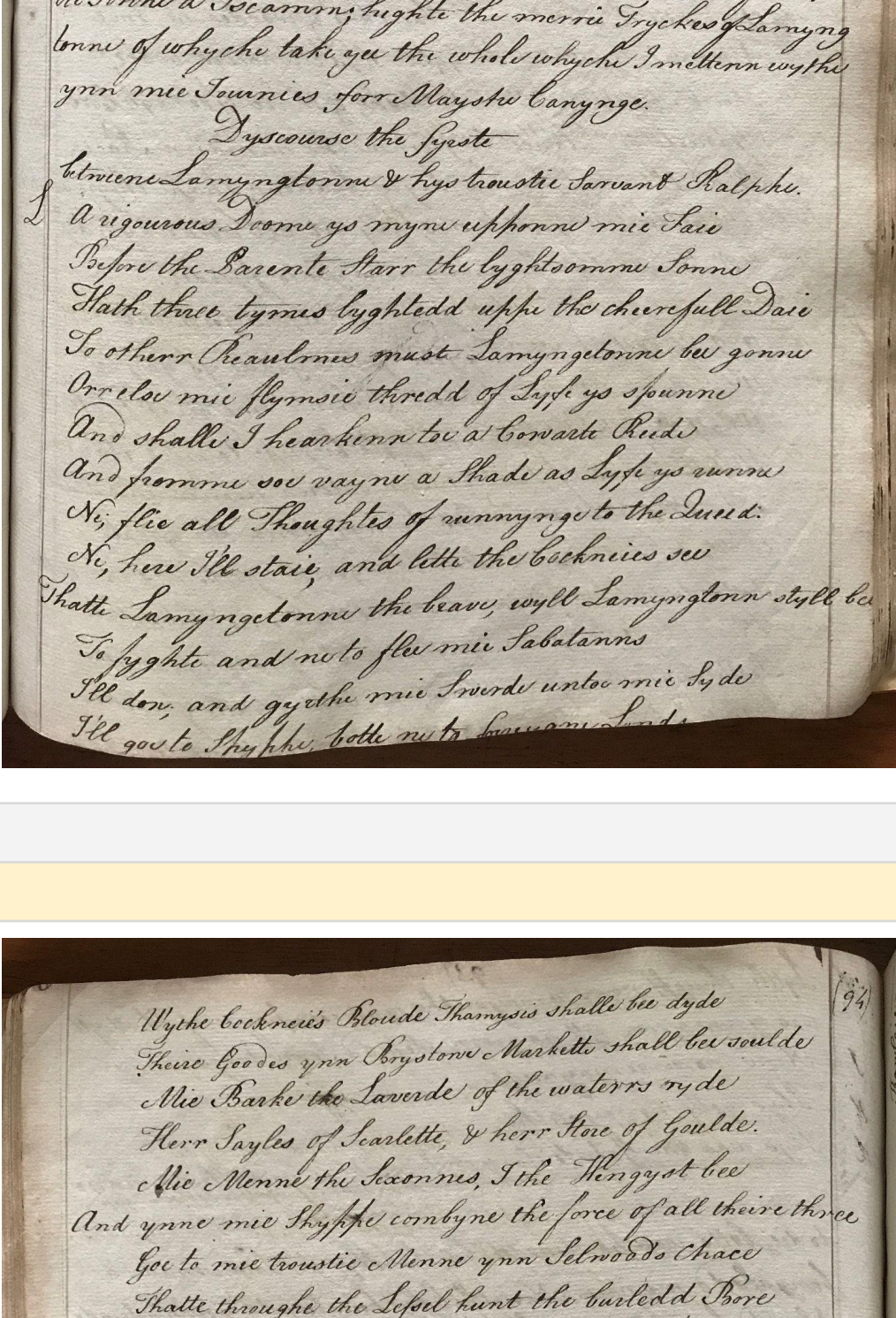
