

- I. Each faction has judicial, executive, and legislative power in their territory. No faction member shall pearl another faction member without just cause and a general peace in the city should try to be observed.
- II. Each faction shall appoint a delegation to the White Cross Council. The Council shall only be called to order to pass a law, make a ruling on an existing one, or settle disputes between member factions and can be called by any two Council members. During each council meeting from among the delegations a speaker shall be chosen to maintain decorum and to ensure a decision is reached before the council is disbanded.
- III. The White Cross Council can make any law it deems appropriate and necessary for the benefit of the city-state of Endeavor. These votes are cast by delegation and require 70% approval to be enacted. These laws supersede faction rules, shall be enforced by all factions, and judgements may be passed on violators of the laws. In all cases when a decision is reached regarding potential violation of any laws in Endeavor a summary of facts and the verdict reached is to be made available to the WCC within 24 hours of the verdict being issued.
- IV. For a faction to be represented on the White Cross Council it must petition the WCC and be unanimously approved to join. If a faction is no longer able to uphold its responsibilities to the city and Council a unanimous vote of the other factions can be used to remove the offending faction.
- V. Unnecessary laws should be avoided, all laws should provide a clear tangible benefit to the factions.
- VI. The factions shall follow and uphold the laws of the WCC or face escalating reprimands and punishments.
- VII. All factions shall pledge to pursue and pearl foreign criminals wanted by any other faction to the best of their ability. Upon pearling they shall hand over the pearl to the faction in which the crime occurred.
- VIII. This document shall be the highest law in the land occupied by any signatory faction and Endeavor, ratification of this document requires unanimous approval of the founding members of the Council. This document can be amended by a unanimous decision of council members.
