

Math 111Z / MTH 111Q Precalculus 1 with Corequisite Support

Do you need MTH 111Z, Precalculus 1?

These programs require MTH 111Z:

Agricultural Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Biological Sciences, Business Administration, Chemistry, Diagnostic Imaging, Engineering, Environmental Science, Equine Science, Exercise and Sport Science, Fisheries and Wildlife, Food and Fermentation Science, General Science, Geology, Health Sciences, Mathematics, Merchandising Management, Nutrition, Physics

What is MTH 111Q?

MTH 111Q is a 1-credit (2 hour) “just in time” support course designed to help you be successful in MTH 111Z. You get extra time on assignments, extra explanations about problems, and extra support from your instructor.

Do you need MTH 111Q?

Yes! Everyone taking MTH 111z will also enroll in MTH 111Q.

Exceptions:

- Students with college credit for MTH 095 are not required to take MTH 111Q, but can if they want extra support.
- Students who have an algebra background may be eligible to register for MTH 111Z without MTH 111Q. Please talk to an advisor or email mathadvisor@linnbenton.edu for more information.
- Students who don't think they'll need the support course should contact a math advisor.

How do I sign up for it?

Each 111Z has an associated corequisite course taught by the same instructor. They are linked in Webrunner and you will be prompted to enroll in the MTH 111Q course at time of registration.

What will we do during MTH 111Q class?

- Students will meet with an instructor 2 hours per week at the scheduled MTH 111Q class times.
- Students will have extra time with the instructor for individual assistance on activities, homework and concepts/topics with which MTH 111Z students typically have difficulty.
- Students will spend time improving soft skills such as time management, organization, mindset, etc.
