Standard Dress for BJEC



The attire outlined in the **Recommended Standard Dress** for BJEC is *not required*, but strongly encouraged. Families are welcome to dress their children in accordance with these guidelines to promote consistency and a unified school environment. However, students will not be penalized for choosing attire outside of the recommended dress, as long as it adheres to the general expectations for modesty, appropriateness, and safety.

Why a Standard Code of Dress Supports Student Success

A consistent standard of dress helps reduce distractions, promotes equity, and builds a sense of community within the school. When students feel part of a shared identity, it contributes to a positive school culture that is conducive to learning. Uniformity in dress minimizes social pressures related to clothing and allows students to focus more fully on their academic and personal growth.
