I need a detailed build for my Sims story, *The Solstice Daughters*. This house is for three supernatural sisters—a mermaid, a vampire, and a werewolf—who lived with their mother, a powerful witch named Miranda Solstice. The house should reflect that Miranda was living there before her mysterious disappearance, with her belongings and magical traces still present.

Key Details:

Location and Environment:

 - **Bathroom:** Elegant and timeless, with vintage fixtures, a large soaking tub, and magical details like glowing runes or enchanted mirrors.

3. Miranda's Study:

- The heart of the house, filled with magical artifacts, books, and a cauldron. Include hidden compartments and an air of mystery, as if she just left in the middle of a spell.

4. Mystical Spaces:
