1. Highland High School will be offering the ASVAB test on March 18th at 7:45 am. Students who do not pass the ISTEP test taken last month can potentially use the ASVAB test as a way to meet graduation requirements without having to take the ISTEP test again. The ASVAB test can also be used for military recruitment and as an interest inventory to determine future options. The test is free to students and information will NOT be shared with the military. Students must use their school email address to complete the form and the deadline for completion is Friday, March 12th. We will send out the list of who will be testing on Monday, March 15th and all students who will test should plan to arrive at the High School Auditorium at 7:45 on March 18th with two number 2 pencils.
