Welcome to 8th Grade Language Arts, SOAR, and ICR for Social Studies! I am excited to be back at school, and I look forward to working with you this year. Please be sure to check out my Teacher's Page on the Middle School North website where you will be able to review my class rules/expectations, supply list, curriculum, grading, etc. I will be using Remind 101 and Schoology for reminders, assignments & important announcements.

Both students and parents may sign up for Remind and subscribe to my webpage.

Please follow your 8th grade schedule. Attendance will be taken daily. Students will be completing assignments for LA class in class or on Schoology. Assignments will be discussed in class and complete directions will be discussed in class or on Schoology. It is expected that students will turn in work ON TIME, following the DUE DATE/TIME as discussed or posted.. Students should always be sure they click "SUBMIT" on the assignment and check that it is turned in correctly. Please check the parent portal regularly. Grades will be entered once the assignment is graded. If an assignment is not turned in, I will indicate "missing" on the Parent Portal. Late work may result in points being taken off the assignment.

Independent reading is required for Language Arts class. Students will be choosing their own independent reading books. Books should be on their reading level and/or in their Lexile range and follow the genre guidelines set in class for that unit. I will be benchmarking each student the first few weeks of school to assess a current reading level for each student. Students may choose books from any source (my classroom library, a local library, their own books, Learning Ally, and I will be adding books they want to read on Bookshare). Your child should be reading a minimum of 20 minutes each day. (M-F) It is extremely important that students are consistently reading daily, as this will help improve their fluency, comprehension and decoding skills.

For their first book, students may continue reading something they are currently reading at home or start something new. It must be **fiction**, but they can read any type of fiction (realistic fiction, historical fiction, science fiction, fantasy, mystery, classics), etc. We will read non-fiction during another unit. It is important that parents/guardians help to monitor the appropriateness of their child's independent reading book at all times. There are many books I can recommend to my students, but I have not

read everything they will choose to read. I thank you in advance for your help!

Suggested supplies have been posted on my <u>Teacher Page</u> and are also attached... Please make sure ipads are charged daily. For help learning how to use the iPad, the district has created a <u>Technology Tutorial Support</u> webpage. For technical assistance, please see the <u>Technology Support page</u> on the MSN website.
