People who get basic income continue to work. The [PBO](#) estimated that a guaranteed basic income would have a very low impact on hours worked – 0.6% or basically “a few hours per year”. During the Ontario Basic Income Pilot, 1/3 of those who were working found *higher* paying work. In fact, basic income helps people secure stable employment, go back to school to retrain, and start new businesses.

Business leaders support basic income, because they see first-hand the impact of automation on jobs and wages, while also understanding how basic income could foster entrepreneurship. Over [180 Canadian CEOs and business leaders](#) have signed a letter supporting basic income. Many technology leaders including Tobi Lutke (Shopify) and Sam Altman (OpenAI) are strong advocates.

As a leader in AI, Canada should be a leader in basic income. The IMF predicts that 60% of jobs will be impacted by AI, while over 1/3 of people believe their job will be replaced in the coming years. Automation will continue to compete away middle class incomes and create a gap between people whose incomes will benefit from AI and everyone else – further driving income and wealth polarization in our country.

Basic income is how we ensure economic freedom and equal opportunity, allowing people to stay out of poverty and train for the jobs of tomorrow.
