#### What to keep in mind:

#### Clarity:

- Avoid ambiguity or vague language.
- Be specific about what aspects of the project you are referring to.

### **Positives and Negatives:**

 Highlight both positive aspects and areas that need improvement. Acknowledge achievements, successful elements, or strong points of the project.

#### **Constructive Criticism:**

• If you identify areas for improvement, offer suggestions or solutions rather than just pointing out problems.

#### Relevance to Goals

- Evaluate the draft in relation to its goals and requirements. Does it meet the intended objectives?
- Comment on how well the project aligns with the initial scope and expectations.

### **Style and Readability:**

• Refer to the lecture for the pointers. <u>Lecture 7</u>

## **Organization:**

• Is the project well-organized? Does its purpose make sense?

## Some questions to keep in mind:

- I am a student taking a class, and I am using this project (video, slides, etc.). Does it help me? What can be changed to improve it?
- I am a tutor teaching a class. Can I use this project to assist during my office hours? What can be changed to improve it?
- I was a student taking a class, and I used this project (video, slides, etc.). Would it have helped you? What can be changed to improve it?
